acknowledged	Recognized as being good or important. <i>Prince Louis s acknowledged heir.</i>
admired	Regarded with admiration.
celebrated	Greatly admired; renowned. <i>A celebrated mathematician.</i>
esteemed	Held in great respect; admired. <i>We dined in my esteemed friend s little room.</i>
exalted	Of high moral or intellectual value; elevated in nature or style- Oliver Franks. <i>It had taken her years of infighting to reach her present exalted rank.</i>

honoured	Regarded with great respect. <i>An honoured guest.</i>
lauded	Highly praised or admired. <i>A lauded author.</i>
revered	Profoundly honored. <i>Revered holy men.</i>
well received	Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.
well thought of	Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.
