<b>acknowledged</b>	Recognized as being good or important. <i>Prince Louis s <b>acknowledged</b> heir.</i>
<b>admired</b>	Regarded with admiration.
<b>celebrated</b>	Greatly admired; renowned. <i>A <b>celebrated</b> mathematician.</i>
<b>esteemed</b>	Held in great respect; admired. <i>We dined in my <b>esteemed</b> friend s little room.</i>
<b><a href="#">exalted</a></b>	Of high moral or intellectual value; elevated in nature or style- Oliver Franks. <i>It had taken her years of infighting to reach her present <b>exalted</b> rank.</i>

<b>honoured</b>	Regarded with great respect. <i>An <b>honoured</b> guest.</i>
<b>lauded</b>	Highly praised or admired. <i>A <b>lauded</b> author.</i>
<b>revered</b>	Profoundly honored. <i><b>Revered</b> holy men.</i>
<b>well received</b>	Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.
<b>well thought of</b>	Wise or advantageous and hence advisable.
