- *A privately controlled company through which an individual or organization conducts a particular kind of business, especially investment.*
- *A medium for the expression or achievement of something.*
- *A substance that facilitates the use of a drug, pigment, or other material mixed with it.*
- *A conveyance that transports people or objects.*
- *A thing used for transporting people or goods, especially on land, such as a car, lorry, or cart.*
- *Any substance that facilitates the use of a drug or pigment or other material that is mixed with it.*
- *A film, television programme, song, etc. that is intended to display the leading performer to the best advantage.*
- *A thing used to express, embody, or fulfil something.*

<b>agent</b>	Any agent or representative of a federal agency or bureau. <i>There is an urgent need for new antimicrobial <b>agents</b> to combat infections.</i>
<b>apparatus</b>	Equipment designed to serve a specific function. <i>The breathing <b>apparatus</b>.</i>
<b>automobile</b>	A motor vehicle with four wheels; usually propelled by an internal combustion engine.
<b><u>channel</u></b>	A service or station using a channel of frequencies. <i>Buoys marked the safe limits of the <b>channel</b>.</i>

<b>conveyance</b>	The action of making an idea, feeling, or impression known or understandable to someone. <i>A mortgage involves a <b>conveyance</b> of property subject to a right of redemption.</i>
<b>fomite</b>	Any inanimate object (as a towel or money or clothing or dishes or books or toys etc.) that can transmit infectious agents from one person to another.
<b><u>instrument</u></b>	The semantic role of the entity (usually inanimate) that the agent uses to perform an action or start a process. <i>The value of learning to play a musical <b>instrument</b>.</i>
<b>machine</b>	A person who acts with the mechanical efficiency of a machine. <i>He was endorsed by the Democratic <b>machine</b>.</i>
<b>machinery</b>	Machines collectively. <i>The complex <b>machinery</b> of negotiation.</i>
<b>means</b>	Financial resources; income. <i>He is a man of <b>means</b>.</i>
<b>means of expression</b>	An instrumentality for accomplishing some end.
<b>means of transport</b>	An instrumentality for accomplishing some end.
<b><u>mechanism</u></b>	The philosophical theory that all phenomena can be explained in terms of physical or biological causes. <i>The immune system's <b>mechanism</b> for detecting pathogens.</i>
<b><u>medium</u></b>	Someone who serves as an intermediary between the living and the dead. <i>Fish require an aqueous <b>medium</b>.</i>
<b>motor vehicle</b>	Machine that converts other forms of energy into mechanical energy and so imparts motion.
<b>motorized vehicle</b>	Any inanimate object (as a towel or money or clothing or dishes or books or toys etc.) that can transmit infectious agents from one person to another.
<b>structure</b>	A particular complex anatomical part of a living thing. <i>The <b>structure</b> consisted of a series of arches.</i>

**bike** A wheeled vehicle that has two wheels and is moved by foot pedals.  
*I m going by **bike**.*

**bus** Travel by bus.  
*Staff were **bussed** in and out of the factory.*

**cab** Ride in a taxicab.  
***Cab** drivers.*

**car** A four wheeled road vehicle that is powered by an engine and is able to carry a small number of people.  
*She drove up in a **car**.*



<b>chauffeur</b>	A person employed to drive a private or hired car. <i>A <b>chauffeur</b> driven limousine.</i>
<b>cycle</b>	A ride on a bicycle. <i><b>Cycle</b> the laundry in this washing program.</i>
<b>cycling</b>	The sport or activity of riding a bicycle. Cycle racing has three main forms: road racing (typically over long distances), pursuit (on an oval track), and cyclo-cross (over rough, open country).
<b>cyclist</b>	A person who rides a bicycle.
<b>driver</b>	A golfer who hits the golf ball with a driver. <i>Mule <b>drivers</b>.</i>
<b>jalopy</b>	An old car in a dilapidated condition. <i>His father got worried about him driving that old <b>jalopy</b> it wasn't safe.</i>
<b>limousine</b>	A car licensed to transport passengers in return for payment, typically more luxurious than a taxi and not fitted with a taximeter. <i>The Prince was whisked away in a black <b>limousine</b>.</i>
<b>motorcycle</b>	Ride a motorcycle.
<b>motorist</b>	Someone who drives (or travels in) an automobile.
<b>mounted</b>	Riding an animal, typically a horse, especially for military or other duty. <i>The trim brass <b>mounted</b> carbine of the ranger.</i>
<b>pedal</b>	Move by working the pedals of a bicycle. <i>They <b>pedalled</b> along the canal towpath.</i>
<b>ride</b>	Ride over along or through. <i>The <b>ride</b> is comfortable though there is a slight roll when cornering.</i>
<b>riding</b>	The sport or activity of riding horses. <i>A <b>riding</b> accident.</i>
<b>scooter</b>	Travel or ride on a scooter. <i><b>Scootering</b> is the most economical and practical form of transportation.</i>
<b>spoke</b>	Each of the bars or wire rods connecting the centre of a wheel to its outer edge.
<b>streetcar</b>	A wheeled vehicle that runs on rails and is propelled by electricity.
<b>surrey</b>	A light four-wheeled horse-drawn carriage; has two or four seats.
<b>taxi</b>	Take a taxi as a means of transport. <i>The plane <b>taxied</b> to a halt at the terminal.</i>
<b>tram</b>	Travel by tram. <i>A <b>tramcar</b> carries coal out of a coal mine.</i>
<b>tricycle</b>	Ride on a tricycle. <i>A small boy <b>tricycled</b> to the end of his driveway.</i>

- truck** Convey goods etc by truck.  
*Truck* fresh vegetables across the mountains.
- trucker** Someone who drives a truck as an occupation.
- van** A caravan.  
*He had been watching the marshalling of the fish vans.*
- wheel** Move along on or as if on wheels or a wheeled vehicle.  
*The stars **wheeled** through the sky.*
