- A conveyance that transports people or objects.
- A thing used for transporting people or goods, especially on land, such as a car, lorry, or cart.
- Any substance that facilitates the use of a drug or pigment or other material that is mixed with it.
- A film, television programme, song, etc. that is intended to display the leading performer to the best advantage.
- A thing used to express, embody, or fulfil something.

| machinery | Machines collectively. The complex machinery of negotiation. |
| means | Financial resources; income. <i>He is a man of means.</i> |
| means of expression | An instrumentality for accomplishing some end. |
| means of transport | An instrumentality for accomplishing some end. |
| <u>mechanism</u> | The philosophical theory that all phenomena can be explained in terms of physical or biological causes. The immune system s mechanism for detecting pathogens. |
| <u>medium</u> | Someone who serves as an intermediary between the living and the dead. <i>Fish require an aqueous medium</i> . |
| motor vehicle | Machine that converts other forms of energy into mechanical energy and so imparts motion. |
| motorized vehicle | Any inanimate object (as a towel or money or clothing or dishes or books or toys etc.) that can transmit infectious agents from one person to another. |
| structure | A particular complex anatomical part of a living thing. The structure consisted of a series of arches. |

| cycling | The sport or activity of riding a bicycle. Cycle racing has three main forms: road racing (typically over long distances), pursuit (on an oval track), and cyclo-cross (over rough, open country). |
| cyclist | A person who rides a bicycle. |
| <u>driver</u> | A golfer who hits the golf ball with a driver. <i>Mule drivers</i> . |
| jalopy | An old car in a dilapidated condition. <i>His father got worried about him driving that old jalopy it wasn t safe.</i> |
| limousine | A car licensed to transport passengers in return for payment, typically more luxurious than a taxi and not fitted with a taximeter. <i>The Prince was whisked away in a black limousine.</i> |
| motorcycle | Ride a motorcycle. |
| motorist | Someone who drives (or travels in) an automobile. |
| mounted | Riding an animal, typically a horse, especially for military or other duty. <i>The trim brass</i> mounted <i>carbine of the ranger.</i> |
| pedal | Move by working the pedals of a bicycle. They pedal led along the canal towpath. |
| <u>ride</u> | Ride over along or through. The ride is comfortable though there is a slight roll when cornering. |
| riding | The sport or activity of riding horses. A riding accident. |
| scooter | Travel or ride on a scooter. Scooter ing is the most economical and practical form of transportation. |
| <u>spoke</u> | Each of the bars or wire rods connecting the centre of a wheel to its outer edge. |
| streetcar | A wheeled vehicle that runs on rails and is propelled by electricity. |
| surrey | A light four-wheeled horse-drawn carriage; has two or four seats. |
| taxi | Take a taxi as a means of transport. The plane taxi ed to a halt at the terminal. |
| tram | Travel by tram. A tram car carries coal out of a coal mine. |
