- *Any inanimate object (as a towel or money or clothing or dishes or books or toys etc.) that can transmit infectious agents from one person to another.*
- *A privately controlled company through which an individual or organization conducts a particular kind of business, especially investment.*
- *A medium for the expression or achievement of something.*
- *A substance that facilitates the use of a drug, pigment, or other material mixed with it.*
- *A conveyance that transports people or objects.*
- *A thing used for transporting people or goods, especially on land, such as a car, lorry, or cart.*
- *Any substance that facilitates the use of a drug or pigment or other material that is mixed with it.*
- *A film, television programme, song, etc. that is intended to display the leading performer to the best advantage.*
- *A thing used to express, embody, or fulfil something.*

agency	A business or organization providing a particular service on behalf of another business, person, or group. <i>An advertising agency.</i>
agent	Any agent or representative of a federal agency or bureau. <i>There is an urgent need for new antimicrobial agents to combat infections.</i>
apparatus	Equipment designed to serve a specific function. <i>The breathing apparatus.</i>
automobile	A motor vehicle with four wheels; usually propelled by an internal combustion engine.
<u>channel</u>	A service or station using a channel of frequencies. <i>Buoys marked the safe limits of the channel.</i>

conveyance	<p>The action of making an idea, feeling, or impression known or understandable to someone. <i>A mortgage involves a conveyance of property subject to a right of redemption.</i></p>
fomite	<p>Any inanimate object (as a towel or money or clothing or dishes or books or toys etc.) that can transmit infectious agents from one person to another.</p>
<u>instrument</u>	<p>The semantic role of the entity (usually inanimate) that the agent uses to perform an action or start a process. <i>The value of learning to play a musical instrument.</i></p>
machine	<p>A person who acts with the mechanical efficiency of a machine. <i>He was endorsed by the Democratic machine.</i></p>
machinery	<p>Machines collectively. <i>The complex machinery of negotiation.</i></p>
means	<p>Financial resources; income. <i>He is a man of means.</i></p>
means of expression	<p>An instrumentality for accomplishing some end.</p>
means of transport	<p>An instrumentality for accomplishing some end.</p>
<u>mechanism</u>	<p>The philosophical theory that all phenomena can be explained in terms of physical or biological causes. <i>The immune system's mechanism for detecting pathogens.</i></p>
<u>medium</u>	<p>Someone who serves as an intermediary between the living and the dead. <i>Fish require an aqueous medium.</i></p>
motor vehicle	<p>Machine that converts other forms of energy into mechanical energy and so imparts motion.</p>
motorized vehicle	<p>Any inanimate object (as a towel or money or clothing or dishes or books or toys etc.) that can transmit infectious agents from one person to another.</p>
structure	<p>A particular complex anatomical part of a living thing. <i>The structure consisted of a series of arches.</i></p>

automobile Travel in an automobile.

bicycle Ride a bicycle.
They spent the holidays bicycling around the beautiful Devonshire countryside.

bike A wheeled vehicle that has two wheels and is moved by foot pedals.
*I m going by **bike**.*

bus Travel by bus.
*Staff were **bussed** in and out of the factory.*

cab Ride in a taxicab.
***Cab** drivers.*

car A four wheeled road vehicle that is powered by an engine and is able to carry a small number of people.
*She drove up in a **car**.*

<u>chauffeur</u>	A person employed to drive a private or hired car. A chauffeur driven limousine.
<u>cycle</u>	A ride on a bicycle. Cycle the laundry in this washing program.
cycling	The sport or activity of riding a bicycle. Cycle racing has three main forms: road racing (typically over long distances), pursuit (on an oval track), and cyclo-cross (over rough, open country).
cyclist	A person who rides a bicycle.
<u>driver</u>	A golfer who hits the golf ball with a driver. Mule drivers .
jalopy	An old car in a dilapidated condition. His father got worried about him driving that old jalopy it wasn't safe.
limousine	A car licensed to transport passengers in return for payment, typically more luxurious than a taxi and not fitted with a taximeter. The Prince was whisked away in a black limousine .
motorcycle	Ride a motorcycle.
motorist	Someone who drives (or travels in) an automobile.
mounted	Riding an animal, typically a horse, especially for military or other duty. The trim brass mounted carbine of the ranger.
pedal	Move by working the pedals of a bicycle. They pedalled along the canal towpath.
<u>ride</u>	Ride over along or through. The ride is comfortable though there is a slight roll when cornering.
riding	The sport or activity of riding horses. A riding accident.
scooter	Travel or ride on a scooter. Scootering is the most economical and practical form of transportation.
<u>spoke</u>	Each of the bars or wire rods connecting the centre of a wheel to its outer edge.
streetcar	A wheeled vehicle that runs on rails and is propelled by electricity.
surrey	A light four-wheeled horse-drawn carriage; has two or four seats.
taxi	Take a taxi as a means of transport. The plane taxied to a halt at the terminal.
tram	Travel by tram. A tramcar carries coal out of a coal mine.
tricycle	Ride on a tricycle. A small boy tricycled to the end of his driveway.

truck

Convey goods etc by truck.

Truck *fresh vegetables across the mountains.*

trucker

Someone who drives a truck as an occupation.

van

A caravan.

*He had been watching the marshalling of the fish **vans**.*

wheel

Move along on or as if on wheels or a wheeled vehicle.

*The stars **wheeled** through the sky.*
