facade	The principal front of a building, that faces on to a street or open space. <i>Her flawless public facade masked private despair.</i>
facing	A protective covering that protects the outside of a building. <i>The bricks were used as a facing on a concrete core.</i>
false appearance	The event of coming into sight.
false front	The side that is forward or prominent.
finish	The act of finishing. <i>His best finish in a major tournament was third.</i>
finishing coat	The act of finishing.
front	The part of a garment covering a person s front. <i>Porridge slopped from the tray on to his shirt front.</i>
fronting	A person used as a cover for some questionable activity.
gloss	Shine or lustre on a smooth surface. <i>He tried to give his falsehood the gloss of moral sanction.</i>
guise	An external form, appearance, or manner of presentation, typically concealing the true nature of something. <i>He visited in the guise of an inspector.</i>
illusion	Something many people believe that is false. <i>Stripes embellish the surface to create the illusion of various wood grain textures.</i>
image	A standard or typical example. <i>He provided America with an image of the good father.</i>

paving	The act of applying paving materials to an area. <i>The company can supply and lay paving.</i>
plating	The process of applying plating. <i>Plating technology.</i>
pose	A posture assumed by models for photographic or artistic purposes. <i>Photographs of boxers in ferocious poses.</i>
posture	A rationalized mental attitude. <i>I got out of the car in an alert posture.</i>
pretence	A false or unsupportable quality. <i>Before the age of two children start to engage in pretence.</i>
revetment	(especially in fortification) a retaining wall or facing of masonry or other material, supporting or protecting a rampart, wall, etc.
semblance	Resemblance similarity. <i>He hoped his claims would have a semblance of authenticity.</i>
show	An undertaking, project, or organization. <i>I didn't have a show.</i>
skin	A unit into which an Aboriginal people is divided typically on the basis of descent each skin being associated with a totemic bird animal or insect. <i>I passed her a plastic bag with skins and hash inside.</i>
smokescreen	(military) screen consisting of a cloud of smoke that obscures movements. <i>He tried to create a smokescreen by quibbling about the statistics.</i>

coat

Form a coat over.
Coat the cake with chocolate.

cover

Form a cover over.
Cover the child with a blanket.

dress

Add a dressing to a salad.
After you **dress** a dry fly be sure to remove any oil before you make your next cast.

inlay

Embed (material or a design) flush with the surface of an object.
Mahogany panelling inlaid with rosewood.

laminate

Create laminate by bonding sheets of material with a bonding material.
I am sanding down oak boards that I **laminated** together for a bar top.

line

Make a mark or lines on a surface.
Line a chimney.

- overlay** Lie on top of.
*A third screen which will **overlay** the others.*
- pave** Cover with a material such as stone or concrete to make suitable for vehicle traffic.
*The yard at the front was **paved** with flagstones.*
- plate** Inoculate cells or infective material on to a culture plate especially with the object of isolating a particular strain of microorganisms or estimating viable cell numbers.
*Matt Wignot **plated** two of Clarkson s runs.*
- put a facing on** Put into a certain place or abstract location.
- skin** Strip the skin off.
*The wound was **skinned** but the strength of his thigh was not restored.*
- surface** Put a coat on cover the surface of furnish with a surface.
*I hope the list key is going to **surface** again.*

integument	A tough outer protective layer, especially that of an animal or plant. <i>This chemical compound is found in the integument of the seed.</i>
leather	Whip with a leather strap. <i>Carlos took his customary 20 metre sprint up to the ball and leathered it.</i>
lining	The act of attaching an inside lining to a garment or curtain etc. <i>Self clean oven linings.</i>
nylon	Stockings or tights made of nylon. <i>A pair of nylons.</i>
obverse	Of or denoting the obverse of a coin or medal. <i>True solitude is the obverse of true society.</i>
outdoor	Pertaining to or concerning the outdoors or outdoor activities. <i>A rugged outdoor type.</i>
outdoors	Where the air is unconfined. <i>A lover of the great outdoors.</i>
outer	An outer garment or part of one. <i>The outer city bypass.</i>
outermost	Furthest from the centre. <i>The outermost layer of the earth.</i>

outside	Coming from the outside. <i>The dog was still barking outside.</i>
peripheral	A peripheral device. <i>Printers and other peripherals.</i>
plywood	A laminate made of thin layers of wood. <i>Plywood benches.</i>
quilted	Made of layers of fabric held together by patterned stitching. <i>A blue quilted jacket.</i>
sapwood	Newly formed outer wood lying between the cambium and the heartwood of a tree or woody plant; usually light colored; active in water conduction.
seemingly	From appearances alone. <i>The child is seemingly healthy but the doctor is concerned.</i>
sheet	A quantity of text or other information contained on a sheet of paper. <i>The rain was sheeting down during the monsoon.</i>
unprepossessing	Creating an unfavorable or neutral first impression. <i>Despite his unprepossessing appearance he had an animal magnetism.</i>
waterproofing	The act of treating something to make it repel water.
wool	Yarn or textile fibre made from wool. <i>Carpets made of 80 per cent wool and 20 per cent nylon.</i>
