Associations of "Vertiginous definition" (30 Words)

clarification	The act of removing solid particles from a liquid. <i>The remaining changes are small clarifications.</i>
clarify	Make clear by removing impurities or solids, as by heating. <i>Clarify the mystery surrounding her death.</i>
define	State or describe exactly the nature, scope, or meaning of. <i>The tree was clearly defined by the light.</i>
depict	Give a description of. <i>Paintings depicting Old Testament scenes.</i>
depiction	A graphic or vivid verbal description. <i>Michelangelo's depictions of the male nude.</i>
describe	To give an account or representation of in words. <i>On the diameter of a circle an equilateral triangle is described.</i>
descriptive	Describing or classifying in an objective and non-judgemental way. <i>The text contains some good descriptive passages.</i>
dictionary	A reference book containing an alphabetical list of words with information about them. <i>I'll look up love in the dictionary.</i>
differentia	Distinguishing characteristics (especially in different species of a genus).
disambiguate	State unambiguously or remove ambiguities from. <i>Word senses can be disambiguated by examining the context.</i>
elucidate	Make (something) clear; explain. <i>In what follows I shall try to elucidate what I believe the problems to be.</i>
enlighten	Give (someone) greater knowledge and understanding about a subject or situation. <i>Christopher had not enlightened Francis as to their relationship.</i>

example	An item of information that is typical of a class or group. <i>The extent of Allied naval support is exampled by the navigational specialists provided.</i>
expatiate	Add details, as to an account or idea; clarify the meaning of and discourse in a learned way, usually in writing. <i>She expatiated on working class novelists.</i>
explain	Define. <i>I explained about Maureen calling round.</i>
explanation	The act of explaining; making something plain or intelligible. <i>My application was rejected without explanation.</i>
explicate	Make plain and comprehensible. <i>An attempt to explicate the relationship between crime and economic forces.</i>
<u>explicit</u>	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>The arrangement had not been made explicit.</i>
<u>exposition</u>	A comprehensive description and explanation of an idea or theory. <i>A systematic exposition of the idea of biodiversity.</i>
expository	Intended to explain or describe something. <i>Clean expository writing.</i>
expound	Present and explain (a theory or idea) in detail. <i>He was expounding a powerful argument.</i>
instruction	A direction or order. <i>Always study the instructions supplied.</i>
instructions	A manual usually accompanying a technical device and explaining how to install or operate it.
<u>interpret</u>	Give an interpretation or rendition of. <i>How do you interpret his behavior.</i>
<u>interpretation</u>	An explanation or way of explaining. <i>His unique interpretation of the Liszt tudes.</i>
mean	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>Heavy rain meant that the pitch was waterlogged.</i>
<u>narrative</u>	The narrated part of a literary work, as distinct from dialogue. <i>A gripping narrative.</i>
rationale	A set of reasons or a logical basis for a course of action or belief. <i>The rationale for capital punishment.</i>

- signification** An exact meaning or sense.
*Film comes closer than other forms of **signification** to resemblance of reality.*
- specific** A medicine that has a mitigating effect on a specific disease.
*A **specific** remedy.*
