## Associations of "Vertiginous definition" (30 Words)

<a href="#">clarification</a>	The act of removing solid particles from a liquid. <i>The remaining changes are small <b>clarifications</b>.</i>
<a href="#">clarify</a>	Make clear by removing impurities or solids, as by heating. <i><b>Clarify</b> the mystery surrounding her death.</i>
<b>define</b>	State or describe exactly the nature, scope, or meaning of. <i>The tree was clearly <b>defined</b> by the light.</i>
<a href="#">depict</a>	Give a description of. <i>Paintings <b>depicting</b> Old Testament scenes.</i>
<a href="#">depiction</a>	A graphic or vivid verbal description. <i>Michelangelo's <b>depictions</b> of the male nude.</i>
<b>describe</b>	To give an account or representation of in words. <i>On the diameter of a circle an equilateral triangle is <b>described</b>.</i>
<a href="#">descriptive</a>	Describing or classifying in an objective and non-judgemental way. <i>The text contains some good <b>descriptive</b> passages.</i>
<b>dictionary</b>	A reference book containing an alphabetical list of words with information about them. <i>I'll look up love in the <b>dictionary</b>.</i>
<b>differentia</b>	Distinguishing characteristics (especially in different species of a genus).
<b>disambiguate</b>	State unambiguously or remove ambiguities from. <i>Word senses can be <b>disambiguated</b> by examining the context.</i>
<a href="#">elucidate</a>	Make (something) clear; explain. <i>In what follows I shall try to <b>elucidate</b> what I believe the problems to be.</i>
<b>enlighten</b>	Give (someone) greater knowledge and understanding about a subject or situation. <i>Christopher had not <b>enlightened</b> Francis as to their relationship.</i>

<b>example</b>	An item of information that is typical of a class or group. <i>The extent of Allied naval support is <b>exampled</b> by the navigational specialists provided.</i>
<b>expatiate</b>	Add details, as to an account or idea; clarify the meaning of and discourse in a learned way, usually in writing. <i>She <b>expatiated</b> on working class novelists.</i>
<b>explain</b>	Define. <i>I <b>explained</b> about Maureen calling round.</i>
<b>explanation</b>	The act of explaining; making something plain or intelligible. <i>My application was rejected without <b>explanation</b>.</i>
<b>explicate</b>	Make plain and comprehensible. <i>An attempt to <b>explicate</b> the relationship between crime and economic forces.</i>
<u>explicit</u>	Of a person stating something in an explicit manner. <i>The arrangement had not been made <b>explicit</b>.</i>
<u>exposition</u>	A comprehensive description and explanation of an idea or theory. <i>A systematic <b>exposition</b> of the idea of biodiversity.</i>
<b>expository</b>	Intended to explain or describe something. <i>Clean <b>expository</b> writing.</i>
<b>expound</b>	Present and explain (a theory or idea) in detail. <i>He was <b>expounding</b> a powerful argument.</i>
<b>instruction</b>	A direction or order. <i>Always study the <b>instructions</b> supplied.</i>
<b>instructions</b>	A manual usually accompanying a technical device and explaining how to install or operate it.
<u>interpret</u>	Give an interpretation or rendition of. <i>How do you <b>interpret</b> his behavior.</i>
<u>interpretation</u>	An explanation or way of explaining. <i>His unique <b>interpretation</b> of the Liszt tudes.</i>
<b>mean</b>	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>Heavy rain <b>meant</b> that the pitch was waterlogged.</i>
<u>narrative</u>	The narrated part of a literary work, as distinct from dialogue. <i>A gripping <b>narrative</b>.</i>
<b>rationale</b>	A set of reasons or a logical basis for a course of action or belief. <i>The <b>rationale</b> for capital punishment.</i>

- signification** An exact meaning or sense.  
*Film comes closer than other forms of **signification** to resemblance of reality.*
- specific** A medicine that has a mitigating effect on a specific disease.  
*A **specific** remedy.*
