**Singular**

**Plural**

I **investigate**                      We **investigate**  
You **investigate**                    You **investigate**  
He/She/It **investigates**        They **investigate**

**Investigate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am investigating**                We **are investigating**  
You **are investigating**            You **are investigating**  
He/She/It **is investigating**      They **are investigating**

**Investigate in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have investigated**                We **have investigated**  
You **have investigated**            You **have investigated**  
He/She/It **has investigated**      They **have investigated**

**Investigate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been investigating**        We **have been investigating**  
You **have been investigating**      You **have been investigating**  
He/She/It **has been investigating**    They **have been investigating**

**Investigate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

I **investigated**                      We **investigated**  
You **investigated**                    You **investigated**  
He/She/It **investigated**          They **investigated**

**Investigate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

I was vestigating      We were vestigating  
You were vestigating      You were vestigating  
He/She/It was vestigating      They were vestigating

**Vestigate in Past Perfect Tense**

I had vestigated      We had vestigated  
You had vestigated      You had vestigated  
He/She/It had vestigated      They had vestigated

**Vestigate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

I had been vestigating      We had been vestigating  
You had been vestigating      You had been vestigating  
He/She/It had been vestigating      They had been vestigating

I will vestigate      We will vestigate  
You will vestigate      You will vestigate  
He/She/It will vestigate      They will vestigate

He/She/It will be vestigating      They will be vestigating
