Vestigate in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular Plural

I **vestigate**You **vestigate**He/She/It **vestigates**They **vestigate**

Vestigate in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I am vestigating We are vestigating
You are vestigating You are vestigating
He/She/It is vestigating They are vestigating

Vestigate in Present Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I have vestigated We have vestigated You have vestigated He/She/It has vestigated They have vestigated

Vestigate in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I have been vestigating
You have been vestigating
He/She/It has been vestigating
They have been vestigating

Vestigate in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural
I vestigated We vestigated
You vestigated You vestigated
He/She/It vestigated They vestigated

Vestigate in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular Plural

I was vestigating We were vestigating
You were vestigating You were vestigating
He/She/It was vestigating They were vestigating

Vestigate in Past Perfect Tense

Singular Plural

I had vestigated We had vestigated You had vestigated You had vestigated He/She/It had vestigated They had vestigated

Vestigate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been vestigating
You had been vestigating
He/She/It had been vestigating
They had been vestigating

Vestigate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will vestigate
You will vestigate
He/She/It will vestigate
They will vestigate

Vestigate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be vestigating
You will be vestigating
He/She/It will be vestigating
They will be vestigating

Vestigate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have vestigated
You will have vestigated
He/She/It will have vestigated
They will have vestigated

Vestigate in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I will have been vestigating
You will have been vestigating
He/She/It will have been vestigating
They will have been vestigating
