| <b>second to none</b>    | A part or voice or instrument or orchestra section lower in pitch than or subordinate to the first.                  |
| <b>successful</b>        | Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status.<br><i>A <b>successful</b> architect.</i>                             |
| <b>top</b>               | Situated at the top or highest position.<br><i>The <b>top</b> end of Fulham Road.</i>                                |
| <b><u>triumphant</u></b> | Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success.<br><i>He couldn't suppress a <b>triumphant</b> smile.</i> |
