- Having won.






## Synonyms of "Victorious" as an adjective (7 Words)

champion	Holding first place in a contest. A <b>champion</b> show dog.
first	Indicating the beginning unit in a series. The <b>first</b> meetings of the new party.
second to none	A part or voice or instrument or orchestra section lower in pitch than or subordinate to the first.
successful	Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status. A <b>successful</b> architect.
top	Situated at the top or highest position. The <b>top</b> end of Fulham Road.
<u>triumphant</u>	Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success. <i>He couldn t suppress a <b>triumphant</b> smile.</i>
winning	Having won. A <b>winning</b> smile.
