Synonyms of "Victorious" as an adjective (7 Words)

champion	Holding first place in a contest. <i>A champion show dog.</i>
first	Indicating the beginning unit in a series. <i>The first meetings of the new party.</i>
second to none	A part or voice or instrument or orchestra section lower in pitch than or subordinate to the first.
successful	Having achieved fame, wealth, or social status. <i>A successful architect.</i>
top	Situated at the top or highest position. <i>The top end of Fulham Road.</i>
<u>triumphant</u>	Joyful and proud especially because of triumph or success. <i>He couldn't suppress a triumphant smile.</i>
winning	Having won. <i>A winning smile.</i>



Usage Examples of "Victorious" as an adjective

- *A victorious army.*
- *The victorious entry.*
- *The team defied the odds and emerged victorious.*
- *He'd participated in the victorious campaigns of the Franco-Prussian War.*
