- A herbaceous plant of temperate regions, typically having purple, blue, or white fivepetalled flowers, one petal of which forms a landing pad for pollinating insects.
- Any of numerous low-growing violas with small flowers.






Synonyms of "Violet" as a noun (1 Word)
