- *Internal organs collectively (especially those in the abdominal cavity).*

Synonyms of "Viscera" as a noun (4 Words)

- entrails** The innermost parts of something.
*A priest would find omens in the steaming **entrails** of a sacrificed animal.*
- gut** A strong cord made from the intestines of sheep and used in surgery.
*He didn't have the **guts** to tell the truth.*
- guts** Fortitude and determination.
*He didn't have the **guts** to try it.*
- innards** The internal workings of a device or machine.

Usage Examples of "Viscera" as a noun

- *'viscera' is the plural form of 'viscus'.*
