Definitions of "Viscosity" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “viscosity” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Resistance of a liquid to shear forces (and hence to flow).*
- *The state of being thick, sticky, and semi-fluid in consistency, due to internal friction.*
- *A quantity expressing the magnitude of internal friction in a fluid, as measured by the force per unit area resisting uniform flow.*



Synonyms of "Viscosity" as a noun (9 Words)

cohesion	The sticking together of particles of the same substance. <i>The work at present lacks cohesion.</i>
degree of density	The seriousness of something (e.g., a burn or crime).
degree of thickness	The highest power of a term or variable.
density	The degree of compactness of a substance. <i>A density of 10 000 per square mile.</i>
firmness	Resolute determination and strength of character. <i>I felt the firmness of his upper arm.</i>
heaviness	Unwelcome burdensome difficulty. <i>The heaviness of a hop aroma.</i>
solidity	The quality or state of being firm or strong in structure. <i>The sheer strength and solidity of Romanesque architecture.</i>

thickness

The distance through an object, as distinct from width or height.
*He gave his eyes time to adjust to the **thickness** of the fog.*

viscousness

Resistance of a liquid to shear forces (and hence to flow).



Usage Examples of "Viscosity" as a noun

- *Cooling the fluid raises its viscosity.*
- *Silicone oils can be obtained with different viscosities.*

forbear	Refrain from doing. <i>She could not forbear weeping.</i>
glue	Join or attach with or as if with glue. <i>What is the glue that holds companies together.</i>
glutinous	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>Glutinous mud.</i>
gum	Cover fill fix or smear with or as if with gum. <i>These trees gum in the Spring.</i>
indomitable	Impossible to subdue. <i>A woman of indomitable spirit.</i>
lubricant	A substance capable of reducing friction by making surfaces smooth or slippery. <i>Squirt in a lubricant on a regular basis.</i>
melt	A sandwich hamburger or other dish containing or topped with melted cheese. <i>Melt butter.</i>
mucous	Of or secreting or covered with or resembling mucus. <i>Mucous glands of the intestine.</i>
obstinacy	The quality or condition of being obstinate; stubbornness. <i>His reputation for obstinacy.</i>
obstinate	Persist stubbornly. <i>Her obstinate determination to pursue a career in radio.</i>
patience	The capacity to accept or tolerate delay, problems, or suffering without becoming annoyed or anxious. <i>You can find bargains if you have the patience to sift through the rubbish.</i>
perseverance	Persistence in doing something despite difficulty or delay in achieving success. <i>Medicine is a field which requires dedication and perseverance.</i>
persistence	The property of a continuous and connected period of time. <i>Cardiff's persistence was rewarded with a try.</i>
pertinacity	Persistent determination.
pitchy	Of the blackest black; similar to the color of jet or coal.
slimy	Morally reprehensible. <i>A slimy little liar.</i>
slippery	(of a surface or object) difficult to hold firmly or stand on because it is smooth, wet, or slimy. <i>The word intended is a decidedly slippery one.</i>

<u>sticky</u>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>Felt sticky and chilly at the same time.</i>
<u>tacky</u>	Tastelessly showy. <i>The paint was still tacky.</i>
<u>tape</u>	Seal or mark off an area or thing with tape. <i>The several recordings were combined on a master tape.</i>
<u>tenacity</u>	The quality or fact of being very determined; determination. <i>The tenacity of certain myths within the historical record.</i>
<u>vigilance</u>	The process of paying close and continuous attention. <i>Security duties that demand long hours of vigilance.</i>
<u>viscid</u>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>The viscid mucus lining of the intestine.</i>
<u>viscous</u>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>Viscous lava.</i>
