## Viscosity as a Noun

### Definitions of "Viscosity" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “viscosity” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Resistance of a liquid to shear forces (and hence to flow.*
- *The state of being thick, sticky, and semi-fluid in consistency, due to internal friction.*
- *A quantity expressing the magnitude of internal friction in a fluid, as measured by the force per unit area resisting uniform flow.*



## Synonyms of "Viscosity" as a noun (9 Words)

<b>cohesion</b>	The sticking together of particles of the same substance. <i>The work at present lacks <b>cohesion</b>.</i>
<b>degree of density</b>	The seriousness of something (e.g., a burn or crime).
<b>degree of thickness</b>	The highest power of a term or variable.
<b>density</b>	The degree of compactness of a substance. <i>A <b>density</b> of 10 000 per square mile.</i>
<b>firmness</b>	Resolute determination and strength of character. <i>I felt the <b>firmness</b> of his upper arm.</i>
<b>heaviness</b>	Unwelcome burdensome difficulty. <i>The <b>heaviness</b> of a hop aroma.</i>
<b>solidity</b>	The quality or state of being firm or strong in structure. <i>The sheer strength and <b>solidity</b> of Romanesque architecture.</i>

**thickness**

The distance through an object, as distinct from width or height.  
*He gave his eyes time to adjust to the **thickness** of the fog.*

**viscousness**

Resistance of a liquid to shear forces (and hence to flow.



**Usage Examples of "Viscosity" as a noun**

- *Cooling the fluid raises its viscosity.*
- *Silicone oils can be obtained with different viscosities.*

*Walsall were indebted to the bravery and **alertness** of their goalkeeper.*

### [endurance](#)

The power to withstand hardship or stress.  
*The annual 24 hour **endurance** race.*

### **epoxy**

Glue with epoxy.  
***Epoxy** the shards.*

### [fluid](#)

Characteristic of a fluid capable of flowing and easily changing shape.  
*The **fluid** political situation of the 1930s.*

<b>forbear</b>	Refrain from doing. <i>She could not <b>forbear</b> weeping.</i>
<b>glue</b>	Join or attach with or as if with glue. <i>What is the <b>glue</b> that holds companies together.</i>
<b>glutinous</b>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i><b>Glutinous</b> mud.</i>
<b>gum</b>	Cover fill fix or smear with or as if with gum. <i>These trees <b>gum</b> in the Spring.</i>
<b>indomitable</b>	Impossible to subdue. <i>A woman of <b>indomitable</b> spirit.</i>
<b>lubricant</b>	A substance capable of reducing friction by making surfaces smooth or slippery. <i>Squirt in a <b>lubricant</b> on a regular basis.</i>
<b>melt</b>	A sandwich hamburger or other dish containing or topped with melted cheese. <i><b>Melt</b> butter.</i>
<b>mucous</b>	Of or secreting or covered with or resembling mucus. <i><b>Mucous</b> glands of the intestine.</i>
<b>obstinacy</b>	The quality or condition of being obstinate; stubbornness. <i>His reputation for <b>obstinacy</b>.</i>
<b>obstinate</b>	Persist stubbornly. <i>Her <b>obstinate</b> determination to pursue a career in radio.</i>
<b>patience</b>	The capacity to accept or tolerate delay, problems, or suffering without becoming annoyed or anxious. <i>You can find bargains if you have the <b>patience</b> to sift through the rubbish.</i>
<b>perseverance</b>	Persistence in doing something despite difficulty or delay in achieving success. <i>Medicine is a field which requires dedication and <b>perseverance</b>.</i>
<b>persistence</b>	The property of a continuous and connected period of time. <i>Cardiff's <b>persistence</b> was rewarded with a try.</i>
<b>pertinacity</b>	Persistent determination.
<b>pitchy</b>	Of the blackest black; similar to the color of jet or coal.
<b>slimy</b>	Morally reprehensible. <i>A <b>slimy</b> little liar.</i>
<b>slippery</b>	(of a surface or object) difficult to hold firmly or stand on because it is smooth, wet, or slimy. <i>The word intended is a decidedly <b>slippery</b> one.</i>

<u><b>sticky</b></u>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>Felt <b>sticky</b> and chilly at the same time.</i>
<u><b>tacky</b></u>	Tastelessly showy. <i>The paint was still <b>tacky</b>.</i>
<u><b>tape</b></u>	Seal or mark off an area or thing with tape. <i>The several recordings were combined on a master <b>tape</b>.</i>
<u><b>tenacity</b></u>	The quality or fact of being very determined; determination. <i>The <b>tenacity</b> of certain myths within the historical record.</i>
<u><b>vigilance</b></u>	The process of paying close and continuous attention. <i>Security duties that demand long hours of <b>vigilance</b>.</i>
<b>viscid</b>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i>The <b>viscid</b> mucus lining of the intestine.</i>
<u><b>viscous</b></u>	Having the sticky properties of an adhesive. <i><b>Viscous</b> lava.</i>
