
## Viscous as an Adjective

### Synonyms of "Viscous" as an adjective (14 Words)

adherent Sticking fast.

The eggs have thick sticky shells to which debris is often **adherent**.

adhesive An adhesive label.

clinging (of a garment) fitting closely to the body and showing its shape.

She wasn t the **clinging** type.

gluey Having a sticky consistency.

Gluey brown paste.

glutinous Like glue in texture; sticky.

**Glutinous** mud.

Covered with adhesive gum.

gummy
His gummy eyes.

mucilaginous Having the sticky properties of an adhesive.

The young leaves are tender and **mucilaginous**.

**pasty**Resembling paste in color; pallid.
He looked pasty and red eyed.

**sticking** Extending out above or beyond a surface or boundary.

A pile of boards **sticking** over the end of his truck.

Having the sticky properties of an adhesive.

The relationship is going through a **sticky** patch.

Having a relatively high resistance to flow.

A particularly **syrupy** moment from a corny film.

(of a glutinous liquid such as paint) not completely dried and slightly sticky

to the touch.

**Tacky** varnish.

treacly Excessively sentimental.

**Treacly** melodramas.

**viscid** Having the sticky properties of an adhesive.

The **viscid** mucus lining of the intestine.

viscid Having a glutinous or sticky consistency.

A quantity expressing the magnitude of internal friction in a fluid, as

**viscosity** measured by the force per unit area resisting uniform flow.

Cooling the fluid raises its viscosity.
