You have vitiated You have vitiated

He/She/It has vitiated They have vitiated

I have been vitiating We have been vitiating

You have been vitiating You have been vitiating

He/She/It has been vitiating They have been vitiating

I was vitiating We were vitiating
You were vitiating You were vitiating
He/She/It was vitiating They were vitiating

Vitiate in Past Perfect Tense

I had vitiated We had vitiated
You had vitiated You had vitiated

He/She/It had vitiated They had vitiated

Vitiate in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular Plural

I had been vitiating
You had been vitiating
You had been vitiating
He/She/It had been vitiating
They had been vitiating

Vitiate in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular Plural

I will vitiate
You will vitiate
He/She/It will vitiate
They will vitiate

Vitiate in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular Plural

I will be vitiating
You will be vitiating
He/She/It will be vitiating
They will be vitiating

Vitiate in Future Perfect Tense



Singular Plural

I will have vitiated We will have vitiated You will have vitiated He/She/It will have vitiated They will have vitiated

I will have been vitiating
You will have been vitiating
He/She/It will have been vitiating
They will have been vitiating
