<b>arresting</b>	Denoting a person or agency that seizes and detains someone by legal authority. <i>An <b>arresting</b> drawing of people turning into animals.</i>
<b><u>authentic</u></b>	(in existentialist philosophy) relating to or denoting an emotionally appropriate, significant, purposive, and responsible mode of human life. <i>The letter is now accepted as an <b>authentic</b> document.</i>
<b>bold</b>	Fearless and daring. <i><b>Bold</b> settlers on some foreign shore.</i>
<b><u>bright</u></b>	Not made dim or less bright. <i>A <b>bright</b> tie.</i>
<b>brilliant</b>	Clear and sharp and ringing. <i>A <b>brilliant</b> solution to the problem.</i>

<b>clear</b>	Clear of charges or deductions. A <b>clear</b> profit.
<b>colourful</b>	Striking in variety and interest. A <b>colourful</b> account.
<b>deep</b>	Relatively deep or strong affecting one deeply. Hit the ball to <b>deep</b> center field.
<b>detailed</b>	(of a work of art) executed with many minor decorative features. More <b>detailed</b> information was needed.
<b>dramatic</b>	Relating to drama or the performance or study of drama. A <b>dramatic</b> sunset.
<b>dynamic</b>	Of or relating to dynamics. A <b>dynamic</b> market.
<b>energetic</b>	Relating to or characterized by energy (in the technical sense). An <b>energetic</b> fund raiser for the college.
<b>evocative</b>	Bringing strong images, memories, or feelings to mind. The building's cramped interiors are highly <b>evocative</b> of past centuries.
<b>eye-catching</b>	Seizing the attention.
<b>faithful</b>	Not having sexual relations with anyone except your husband or wife, or your boyfriend or girlfriend. Employees who had notched up decades of <b>faithful</b> service.
<b>fascinating</b>	Capturing interest as if by a spell. A <b>fascinating</b> story.
<b>fiery</b>	Showing strong emotion, typically anger. <b>Fiery</b> oratory.
<b>flamboyant</b>	Of or denoting a style of French Gothic architecture marked by wavy flame-like tracery and ornate decoration. A <b>flamboyant</b> bow tie.
<b>flaming</b>	Very hot. Her <b>flaming</b> hair.
<b>glaring</b>	Giving out or reflecting a strong or dazzling light. Their <b>glaring</b> eyes.
<b>glowing</b>	Highly enthusiastic. <b>Glowing</b> praise.
<b>graphic</b>	Describing nudity or sexual activity in graphic detail. A <b>graphic</b> presentation of the data.
<b>impressive</b>	Making a strong or vivid impression. An <b>impressive</b> ceremony.



<b>intense</b>	Extremely sharp or intense. <i>The heat was <b>intense</b>.</i>
<b>interesting</b>	Arousing curiosity or interest; holding or catching the attention. <i>It will be very <b>interesting</b> to see what they come up with.</i>
<b>lifelike</b>	Evoking lifelike images within the mind. <i>A <b>lifelike</b> portrait.</i>
<b>lively</b>	(of a boat) rising lightly to the waves. <i>A <b>lively</b> period in history.</i>
<b>lucid</b>	Having a clear mind. <i><b>Lucid</b> directions.</i>
<b>pictorial</b>	Pertaining to or consisting of pictures. <i><b>Pictorial</b> perspective.</i>
<b>picturesque</b>	(of a place or building) visually attractive, especially in a quaint or charming way. <i>Ruined abbeys and <b>picturesque</b> villages.</i>
<b>powerful</b>	Possessing physical strength and weight rugged and powerful. <i>Computers are now more compact and <b>powerful</b>.</i>
<b>radiant</b>	Of an appliance designed to emit radiant energy especially for cooking or heating. <i>He praised her <b>radiant</b> self confidence.</i>
<b>realistic</b>	Representing what is real; not abstract or ideal. <i>A <b>realistic</b> novel.</i>
<b>rich</b>	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. <i>A protein <b>rich</b> diet.</i>
<b>scintillating</b>	Having brief brilliant points or flashes of light. <i><b>Scintillating</b> wit.</i>
<b>spirited</b>	Made lively or spirited. <i>A <b>spirited</b> campaigner for women s rights.</i>
<b>stimulating</b>	That stimulates. <i>A rich and <b>stimulating</b> working environment.</i>
<b>striking</b>	Sensational in appearance or thrilling in effect. <i>It is <b>striking</b> that no research into the problem is being carried out.</i>
<b>strong</b>	Strong and sure. <i>She cut through the water with her <b>strong</b> arms.</i>
<b>vibrant</b>	Of colors that are bright and striking. <i>A <b>vibrant</b> cosmopolitan city.</i>

<b>vigorous</b>	Strong, healthy, and full of energy. <i>A <b>vigorous</b> foreign policy.</i>
<b>vital</b>	Full of spirit; full of life. <i>The wound is <b>vital</b>.</i>
<b>vivacious</b>	Attractively lively and animated (typically used of a woman). <i>A charming and <b>vivacious</b> hostess.</i>
<b>warm</b>	Psychologically warm friendly and responsive. <i>A <b>warm</b> debate arose.</i>
<b>zestful</b>	Marked by spirited enjoyment. <i>A <b>zestful</b> and exuberant player.</i>

<b>accurate</b>	Of an instrument or method capable of giving accurate information. <i>The accounting was <b>accurate</b>.</i>
<b>animated</b>	Made to appear to move as living creatures do. <i><b>Animated</b> puppets.</i>
<b>bright</b>	With brightness. <i>The room was <b>bright</b> and airy.</i>
<b>colorful</b>	Striking in variety and interest. <i><b>Colorful</b> autumn leaves.</i>
<b>description</b>	A spoken or written account of a person, object, or event. <i>It is laughably easy to buy drugs of all <b>descriptions</b>.</i>
<b>detailed</b>	Having many details or facts; showing attention to detail. <i>A <b>detailed</b> plan.</i>
<b>ebullient</b>	(of liquid or matter) boiling or agitated as if boiling. <i>She sounded <b>ebullient</b> and happy.</i>



<b>eidetic</b>	Of visual imagery of almost photographic accuracy. An <b>eidetic</b> memory.
<b>evocation</b>	Imaginative re-creation. The vivid <b>evocation</b> of stillness in the title poem.
<b>exactitude</b>	Care and attention to detail. A man of great <b>exactitude</b> .
<b>graphic</b>	A graphical item displayed on a screen or stored as data. <b>Graphic</b> accounts of battle.
<b>illustration</b>	A visual representation (a picture or diagram) that is used make some subject more pleasing or easier to understand. By way of <b>illustration</b> I refer to the following case.
<b>iridescent</b>	Showing luminous colours that seem to change when seen from different angles. An <b>iridescent</b> oil slick.
<b>lifelike</b>	Evoking lifelike images within the mind. A <b>lifelike</b> portrait.
<b>lively</b>	Difficult or challenging. A <b>lively</b> period in history.
<b>meticulous</b>	Marked by precise accordance with details. Almost worryingly <b>meticulous</b> in his business formalities.
<b>monochromatic</b>	Of or relating to monochromatism. It employs diffraction to focus <b>monochromatic</b> light.
<b>painstakingly</b>	With great care and thoroughness. The property has been <b>painstakingly</b> restored by its current owners.
<b>painted</b>	Lacking substance or vitality as if produced by painting. The <b>painted</b> desert.
<b>pedantic</b>	Marked by a narrow focus on or display of learning especially its trivial aspects. His analyses are careful and even painstaking but never <b>pedantic</b> .
<b>pert</b>	Characterized by a lightly pert and exuberant quality. She had a <b>pert</b> nose and deep blue eyes.
<b>pictorial</b>	Pertaining to or consisting of pictures. <b>Pictorial</b> records.
<b>picturesque</b>	Strikingly expressive. A <b>picturesque</b> village.
<b>polychrome</b>	Color with many colors make polychrome. Painters gilded and <b>polychromed</b> the wooden carvings.
