clear	Clear of charges or deductions. <i>A clear profit.</i>
colourful	Striking in variety and interest. <i>A colourful account.</i>
deep	Relatively deep or strong affecting one deeply. <i>Hit the ball to deep center field.</i>
detailed	(of a work of art) executed with many minor decorative features. <i>More detailed information was needed.</i>
dramatic	Relating to drama or the performance or study of drama. <i>A dramatic sunset.</i>
dynamic	Of or relating to dynamics. <i>A dynamic market.</i>
energetic	Relating to or characterized by energy (in the technical sense). <i>An energetic fund raiser for the college.</i>
evocative	Bringing strong images, memories, or feelings to mind. <i>The building's cramped interiors are highly evocative of past centuries.</i>
eye-catching	Seizing the attention.
faithful	Not having sexual relations with anyone except your husband or wife, or your boyfriend or girlfriend. <i>Employees who had notched up decades of faithful service.</i>
fascinating	Capturing interest as if by a spell. <i>A fascinating story.</i>
fiery	Showing strong emotion, typically anger. <i>Fiery oratory.</i>
flamboyant	Of or denoting a style of French Gothic architecture marked by wavy flame-like tracery and ornate decoration. <i>A flamboyant bow tie.</i>
flaming	Very hot. <i>Her flaming hair.</i>
glaring	Giving out or reflecting a strong or dazzling light. <i>Their glaring eyes.</i>
glowing	Highly enthusiastic. <i>Glowing praise.</i>
graphic	Describing nudity or sexual activity in graphic detail. <i>A graphic presentation of the data.</i>
impressive	Making a strong or vivid impression. <i>An impressive ceremony.</i>

intense	Extremely sharp or intense. <i>The heat was intense.</i>
interesting	Arousing curiosity or interest; holding or catching the attention. <i>It will be very interesting to see what they come up with.</i>
lifelike	Evoking lifelike images within the mind. <i>A lifelike portrait.</i>
lively	(of a boat) rising lightly to the waves. <i>A lively period in history.</i>
lucid	Having a clear mind. <i>Lucid directions.</i>
pictorial	Pertaining to or consisting of pictures. <i>Pictorial perspective.</i>
picturesque	(of a place or building) visually attractive, especially in a quaint or charming way. <i>Ruined abbeys and picturesque villages.</i>
powerful	Possessing physical strength and weight rugged and powerful. <i>Computers are now more compact and powerful.</i>
radiant	Of an appliance designed to emit radiant energy especially for cooking or heating. <i>He praised her radiant self confidence.</i>
realistic	Representing what is real; not abstract or ideal. <i>A realistic novel.</i>
rich	Marked by richness and fullness of flavor. <i>A protein rich diet.</i>
scintillating	Having brief brilliant points or flashes of light. <i>Scintillating wit.</i>
spirited	Made lively or spirited. <i>A spirited campaigner for women s rights.</i>
stimulating	That stimulates. <i>A rich and stimulating working environment.</i>
striking	Sensational in appearance or thrilling in effect. <i>It is striking that no research into the problem is being carried out.</i>
strong	Strong and sure. <i>She cut through the water with her strong arms.</i>
vibrant	Of colors that are bright and striking. <i>A vibrant cosmopolitan city.</i>

vigorous	Strong, healthy, and full of energy. A vigorous foreign policy.
vital	Full of spirit; full of life. The wound is vital .
vivacious	Attractively lively and animated (typically used of a woman). A charming and vivacious hostess.
warm	Psychologically warm friendly and responsive. A warm debate arose.
zestful	Marked by spirited enjoyment. A zestful and exuberant player.

bright	With brightness. <i>The room was bright and airy.</i>
colorful	Striking in variety and interest. <i>Colorful autumn leaves.</i>
description	A spoken or written account of a person, object, or event. <i>It is laughably easy to buy drugs of all descriptions.</i>
detailed	Having many details or facts; showing attention to detail. <i>A detailed plan.</i>
ebullient	(of liquid or matter) boiling or agitated as if boiling. <i>She sounded ebullient and happy.</i>

eidetic	Of visual imagery of almost photographic accuracy. <i>An eidetic memory.</i>
evocation	Imaginative re-creation. <i>The vivid evocation of stillness in the title poem.</i>
exactitude	Care and attention to detail. <i>A man of great exactitude.</i>
graphic	A graphical item displayed on a screen or stored as data. <i>Graphic accounts of battle.</i>
illustration	A visual representation (a picture or diagram) that is used make some subject more pleasing or easier to understand. <i>By way of illustration I refer to the following case.</i>
iridescent	Showing luminous colours that seem to change when seen from different angles. <i>An iridescent oil slick.</i>
lifelike	Evoking lifelike images within the mind. <i>A lifelike portrait.</i>
lively	Difficult or challenging. <i>A lively period in history.</i>
meticulous	Marked by precise accordance with details. <i>Almost worryingly meticulous in his business formalities.</i>
monochromatic	Of or relating to monochromatism. <i>It employs diffraction to focus monochromatic light.</i>
painstakingly	With great care and thoroughness. <i>The property has been painstakingly restored by its current owners.</i>
painted	Lacking substance or vitality as if produced by painting. <i>The painted desert.</i>
pedantic	Marked by a narrow focus on or display of learning especially its trivial aspects. <i>His analyses are careful and even painstaking but never pedantic.</i>
pert	Characterized by a lightly pert and exuberant quality. <i>She had a pert nose and deep blue eyes.</i>
pictorial	Pertaining to or consisting of pictures. <i>Pictorial records.</i>
picturesque	Strikingly expressive. <i>A picturesque village.</i>
polychrome	Color with many colors make polychrome. <i>Painters gilded and polychromed the wooden carvings.</i>
