| bake | A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten. <i>A vegetable bake.</i> |
| baked | Cooked by dry heat (as in an oven). <i>Baked goods.</i> |
| batter | A liquid or semiliquid mixture, as of flour, eggs, and milk, used in cooking. <i>The loss of his baby turned him into a domineering bully who battered his partner.</i> |
| bread | Coat food with breadcrumbs before cooking. <i>Bread the pork chops before frying them.</i> |
| breakfast | Eat breakfast. <i>I often have toast for my breakfast.</i> |
| burnt | Treated by heating to a high temperature but below the melting or fusing point. <i>Barricaded the street with burnt out cars.</i> |
| butter | Spread butter on. <i>Lily battered a slice of toast.</i> |
| cake | An item of savoury food formed into a flat round shape, and typically baked or fried. <i>A starter of goat s cheese and potato cakes.</i> |
| cooked | Having been prepared for eating by the application of heat. <i>Cooked chicken can last longer than two days when stored properly.</i> |
| cornbread | Bread made primarily of cornmeal. |
| crisp | Make brown and crisp by heating. <i>Cut down on fatty snacks such as crisps.</i> |
| crispy | (of food) having a firm, dry, and brittle surface or texture. <i>Crispy fried bacon.</i> |

| dessert | The sweet course eaten at the end of a meal. A dessert of chocolate mousse. |
| doubt | Consider unlikely or have doubts about. They had doubts that they would ever win. |
| falter | Speak hesitantly. A Adam he faltered . |
| fried | Under the influence of alcohol or drugs. A breakfast of fried eggs and bacon. |
| fry | Any of various types of offal, usually eaten fried. They fry cop killers in Texas. |
| grill | A restaurant serving grilled food. Grill the sausages. |
| hesitate | Be reluctant to do something. Authorities hesitate to quote exact figures. |
| microwave | An oven that uses microwaves to cook or heat food. Microwave radiation. |
| oven | An enclosed compartment, usually part of a cooker, for cooking and heating food. Bake the dish in a preheated oven . |
| pancake | With reference to an aircraft make or cause to make a pancake landing. Crispy pancakes filled with cheese. |
| recipe | A set of instructions for preparing a particular dish, including a list of the ingredients required. It would be useless to enumerate all the drugs and recipes for their application which have been tried. |
| roast | A particular type of roasted coffee. She was going to roast a leg of mutton for Sunday dinner. |
| sandwich | Relating to a sandwich course. She was sandwiched in her airplane seat between two fat men. |
| smoked | (of food, especially meat or fish) cured or preserved by exposure to smoke. A plate of smoked salmon. |
| stove | Treat an object by heating it in a stove in order to apply a desired surface coating. Dinner was already on the stove . |
| toast | Propose a toast to. He found himself the toast of the baseball world. |

toaster Someone who proposes a toast; someone who drinks to the health of success of someone or some venture.

warmed Having been warmed up.
