## Associations of "Waffling" (30 Words)

<b>bake</b>	A social gathering at which baked food of a specified kind is eaten. <i>A vegetable <b>bake</b>.</i>
<b>baked</b>	Cooked by dry heat (as in an oven). <i><b>Baked</b> goods.</i>
<b>batter</b>	A liquid or semiliquid mixture, as of flour, eggs, and milk, used in cooking. <i>The loss of his baby turned him into a domineering bully who <b>battered</b> his partner.</i>
<b>bread</b>	Coat food with breadcrumbs before cooking. <i><b>Bread</b> the pork chops before frying them.</i>
<b>breakfast</b>	Eat breakfast. <i>I often have toast for my <b>breakfast</b>.</i>
<b>burnt</b>	Treated by heating to a high temperature but below the melting or fusing point. <i>Barricaded the street with <b>burnt</b> out cars.</i>
<b>butter</b>	Spread butter on. <i>Lily <b>battered</b> a slice of toast.</i>
<b>cake</b>	An item of savoury food formed into a flat round shape, and typically baked or fried. <i>A starter of goat s cheese and potato <b>cakes</b>.</i>
<b>cooked</b>	Having been prepared for eating by the application of heat. <i><b>Cooked</b> chicken can last longer than two days when stored properly.</i>
<b>cornbread</b>	Bread made primarily of cornmeal.
<b>crisp</b>	Make brown and crisp by heating. <i>Cut down on fatty snacks such as <b>crisps</b>.</i>
<b>crispy</b>	(of food) having a firm, dry, and brittle surface or texture. <i><b>Crispy</b> fried bacon.</i>

<b>dessert</b>	The sweet course eaten at the end of a meal. A <b>dessert</b> of chocolate mousse.
<b>doubt</b>	Consider unlikely or have doubts about. They had <b>doubts</b> that they would ever win.
<b>falter</b>	Speak hesitantly. A Adam he <b>faltered</b> .
<b>fried</b>	Under the influence of alcohol or drugs. A breakfast of <b>fried</b> eggs and bacon.
<b>fry</b>	Any of various types of offal, usually eaten fried. They <b>fry</b> cop killers in Texas.
<b>grill</b>	A restaurant serving grilled food. <b>Grill</b> the sausages.
<b>hesitate</b>	Be reluctant to do something. Authorities <b>hesitate</b> to quote exact figures.
<b>microwave</b>	An oven that uses microwaves to cook or heat food. <b>Microwave</b> radiation.
<b>oven</b>	An enclosed compartment, usually part of a cooker, for cooking and heating food. Bake the dish in a preheated <b>oven</b> .
<b>pancake</b>	With reference to an aircraft make or cause to make a pancake landing. Crispy <b>pancakes</b> filled with cheese.
<b>recipe</b>	A set of instructions for preparing a particular dish, including a list of the ingredients required. It would be useless to enumerate all the drugs and <b>recipes</b> for their application which have been tried.
<b>roast</b>	A particular type of roasted coffee. She was going to <b>roast</b> a leg of mutton for Sunday dinner.
<b>sandwich</b>	Relating to a sandwich course. She was <b>sandwiched</b> in her airplane seat between two fat men.
<b>smoked</b>	(of food, especially meat or fish) cured or preserved by exposure to smoke. A plate of <b>smoked</b> salmon.
<b>stove</b>	Treat an object by heating it in a stove in order to apply a desired surface coating. Dinner was already on the <b>stove</b> .
<b>toast</b>	Propose a toast to. He found himself the <b>toast</b> of the baseball world.

**toaster** Someone who proposes a toast; someone who drinks to the health of success of someone or some venture.

**warmed** Having been warmed up.
