Definitions of "Wannabe" as a noun

- An ambitious and aspiring young person.
- A person who tries to be like someone else or to fit in with a particular group of people.

Synonyms of "Wannabe" as a noun (6 Words)

aspirant A person who has ambitions to achieve something. A lofty aspirant. **aspirer** An ambitious and aspiring young person. **budding** Reproduction of some unicellular organisms (such as yeasts) by growth and specialization followed by the separation by constriction of a part of the parent. **hopeful** A person likely or hoping to succeed. Promotion hopefuls Huddersfield. **wannabee** An ambitious and aspiring young person.

wishful An expression of some desire or inclination.



Usage Examples of "Wannabe" as a noun

- A star-struck wannabe.
- The audience was full of Madonna wannabes.
- For every success story there are thousands of wannabees who don't make it.
