| aspirant | A person who has ambitions to achieve something. <i>A lofty aspirant.</i> |
| aspirer | An ambitious and aspiring young person. |
| budding | Reproduction of some unicellular organisms (such as yeasts) by growth and specialization followed by the separation by constriction of a part of the parent. |
| hopeful | A person likely or hoping to succeed. <i>Promotion hopefuls Huddersfield.</i> |
| wannabee | An ambitious and aspiring young person. |
| wishful | An expression of some desire or inclination. |

Usage Examples of "Wannabe" as a noun

- *A star-struck wannabe.*
- *The audience was full of Madonna wannabes.*
- *For every success story there are thousands of wannabees who don't make it.*
