Definitions of "Wardrobe" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “wardrobe” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *Collection of costumes belonging to a theatrical company.*
- *Collection of clothing belonging to one person.*
- *A person's entire collection of clothes.*
- *The costume department or costumes of a theatre or film company.*
- *A department of a royal or noble household in charge of clothing.*
- *A tall piece of furniture that provides storage space for clothes; has a door and rails or hooks for hanging clothes.*
- *A large, tall cupboard or recess in which clothes may be hung or stored.*



Synonyms of "Wardrobe" as a noun (8 Words)

cabinet

Housing for electronic instruments, as radio or television.
A **cabinet** meeting.

closet

A small room, especially one used for storing things or for private study.

He has a **closet** full of designer suits.

clothes cupboard

Clothing in general.

collection of clothes

The act of gathering something together.

cupboard

A recess or piece of furniture with a door and typically shelves, used for storage.

A broom **cupboard**.

locker

A fastener that locks or closes.

press

A device for applying pressure to something in order to flatten or shape it or to extract juice or oil.

The system summons medical help at the **press** of a button.

storage room

A depository for goods.

Kick give a boot to.
*He got a **boot** in the stomach.*

briefing

The action of informing or instructing someone.
*Today's **briefing** of Nato allies.*

cabinet

Persons appointed by a head of state to head executive departments of government and act as official advisers.
*A **cabinet** meeting.*

closet	Shut (someone) away, especially in private conference or study. <i>She tries to have a relationship with another woman while remaining in the closet.</i>
clothes	Bedclothes. <i>A clothes shop.</i>
communicate	An official report (usually sent in haste).
compartment	A division of a railway carriage marked by partitions. <i>A first class compartment.</i>
cupboard	A small room (or recess) or cabinet used for storage space. <i>A broom cupboard.</i>
desk	A piece of furniture with a flat or sloping surface and typically with drawers, at which one can read, write, or do other work. <i>An extra desk of first and second violins.</i>
desktop	The working area of a computer screen regarded as a representation of a notional desktop and containing icons representing items such as files. <i>A new low end desktop.</i>
drawer	Knickers or underpants. <i>Queen Victoria was notoriously careless with her drawers.</i>
equip	Prepare (someone) mentally for a particular situation or task. <i>They equipped themselves for the campaign.</i>
folder	A small book usually having a paper cover.
freezer	Electric refrigerator (trade name Deepfreeze) in which food is frozen and stored for long periods of time. <i>There are some steaks in the freezer.</i>
fridge	A refrigerator in which the coolant is pumped around by an electric motor. <i>She put the carton of milk back in the fridge.</i>
furniture	Furnishings that make a room or other area ready for occupancy. <i>They had too much furniture for the small apartment.</i>
kettle	The quantity a kettle will hold. <i>Activists in the kettle were protesting at being held and resisting arrest.</i>
kitchen	A set of fittings and units that are sold together and fixed in place in a kitchen. <i>Kitchen Swahili.</i>
larder	A supply of food especially for a household.
leather	Whip with a leather strap. <i>A leather jacket.</i>

outfit	Provide with equipment. <i>Planes outfitted with sophisticated electronic gear.</i>
press	Press and smooth with a heated iron. <i>Rose did not press the point.</i>
printing	Handwriting in which the letters are written separately rather than being joined together. <i>This squiggly squarish printing was the only way he could write.</i>
refrigerator	An appliance or compartment which is artificially kept cool and used to store food and drink Modern refrigerators generally make use of the cooling effect produced when a volatile liquid is forced to evaporate in a sealed system in which it can be condensed back to liquid outside the refrigerator.
reporting	The news as presented by reporters for newspapers or radio or television.
room	A set of rooms typically rented in which a person couple or family live. <i>The whole room burst into an uproar of approval.</i>
skimpy	(of clothing) revealing the body. <i>A skimpy dress.</i>
sofa	A long upholstered seat with a back and arms, for two or more people. <i>Sofa cushions.</i>
top	Reach or ascend the top of. <i>The mower cuts off the tops of the grass.</i>
wear	The wearing of something or the state of being worn as clothing. <i>The suit has about another 10 years of normal wear left in it.</i>
