

- Collection of costumes belonging to a theatrical company.
- Collection of clothing belonging to one person.
- A person's entire collection of clothes.
- The costume department or costumes of a theatre or film company.
- A department of a royal or noble household in charge of clothing.
- A tall piece of furniture that provides storage space for clothes; has a door and rails or hooks for hanging clothes.
- A large, tall cupboard or recess in which clothes may be hung or stored.

press Press and smooth with a heated iron.
