## Synonyms of "Warring" as an adjective (7 Words)

- belligerent** Characteristic of an enemy or one eager to fight.  
*The mood at the meeting was **belligerent**.*
- clashing** Sharply and harshly discordant.  
***Clashing** colors.*
- conflicting** Incompatible or at variance; contradictory.  
***Conflicting** opinions.*
- fighting** Displaying or engaging in violence, combat, or aggression.  
*Review the **fighting** forces.*
- militant** Favoured confrontational or violent methods in support of a political or social cause.  
***Militant** in fighting for better wages for workers.*
- opposing** In conflict or competition with someone or something.  
*The brothers fought on **opposing** sides in the war.*
- war-ridden** Engaged in war.

- *Warring factions.*
- *A warring couple.*

- activism** A policy of taking direct and militant action to achieve a political or social goal.

- aggressive** Behaving or done in a determined and forceful way.  
*We needed more growth to pursue our **aggressive** acquisition strategy.*
- argumentative** Using or characterized by systematic reasoning.  
*An intelligent but **argumentative** child.*
- army** The army of the United States of America the agency that organizes and trains soldiers for land warfare.  
*He joined the **army** at 16.*

| <b>fighter</b>                | A person or animal that fights.<br><i>World War II <b>fighter</b> planes.</i>  |
| <b><u>hostile</u></b>         | Characterized by enmity or ill will.<br><b>Hostile</b> tender offer.   |

| <b><u>military</u></b>  | Characteristic of or associated with soldiers or the military.<br><i>As a young man he joined the <b>military</b> and pursued a career in the Army.</i>                            |
| <b>militia</b>          | A military force that is raised from the civil population to supplement a regular army in an emergency.<br><i>Their troops were untrained <b>militia</b>.</i>                      |
| <b>pugnacious</b>       | Ready and able to resort to force or violence- Herman Melville.<br><i>His public statements became increasingly <b>pugnacious</b>.</i>   |
| <b>scrappy</b>          | Determined, argumentative, or pugnacious.<br><i>He had a <b>scrappy</b> New York temperament.</i>  |
