Present Tense	<b>waterboard / waterboards</b>
Past Tense	<b>waterboarded</b>
Present Participle	<b>waterboarding</b>
Past Participle	<b>waterboarded</b>

## Conjugate Waterboard

**Waterboard in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>waterboard</b>	We <b>waterboard</b>
You <b>waterboard</b>	You <b>waterboard</b>
He/She/It <b>waterboards</b>	They <b>waterboard</b>

### **Waterboard in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am waterboarding</b>	We <b>are waterboarding</b>
You <b>are waterboarding</b>	You <b>are waterboarding</b>
He/She/It <b>is waterboarding</b>	They <b>are waterboarding</b>

### **Waterboard in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have waterboarded</b>	We <b>have waterboarded</b>
You <b>have waterboarded</b>	You <b>have waterboarded</b>
He/She/It <b>has waterboarded</b>	They <b>have waterboarded</b>

### **Waterboard in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been waterboarding</b>	We <b>have been waterboarding</b>
You <b>have been waterboarding</b>	You <b>have been waterboarding</b>
He/She/It <b>has been waterboarding</b>	They <b>have been waterboarding</b>

### **Waterboard in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**I was waterboarding**

**We were waterboarding**

**You were waterboarding**

**You were waterboarding**

**He/She/It was waterboarding** **They were waterboarding**

### **Waterboard in Past Perfect Tense**

**I had waterboarded**

**We had waterboarded**

**You had waterboarded**

**You had waterboarded**

**He/She/It had waterboarded** **They had waterboarded**

### **Waterboard in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**I had been waterboarding**

**We had been waterboarding**

**You had been waterboarding**

**You had been waterboarding**

**He/She/It had been waterboarding** **They had been waterboarding**
