Present Tense	<b>waterlog / waterlogs</b>
Past Tense	<b>waterlogged</b>
Present Participle	<b>waterlogging</b>
Past Participle	<b>waterlogged</b>

I **waterlog**

We **waterlog**

You **waterlog**

You **waterlog**

He/She/It **waterlogs** They **waterlog**

## **Waterlog in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **am waterlogging**

We **are waterlogging**

You **are waterlogging**

You **are waterlogging**

He/She/It **is waterlogging** They **are waterlogging**

## **Waterlog in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **have waterlogged**

We **have waterlogged**

You **have waterlogged**

You **have waterlogged**

He/She/It **has waterlogged** They **have waterlogged**

## **Waterlog in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

I **have been waterlogging**

We **have been waterlogging**

You **have been waterlogging**

I **waterlogged**

We **waterlogged**

You **waterlogged**

## **Waterlog in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was waterlogging                      We were waterlogging  
You were waterlogging                You were waterlogging  
He/She/It was waterlogging        They were waterlogging

**Waterlog in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had waterlogged                      We had waterlogged  
You had waterlogged                You had waterlogged  
He/She/It had waterlogged        They had waterlogged

**Waterlog in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been waterlogging              We had been waterlogging  
You had been waterlogging            You had been waterlogging  
He/She/It had been waterlogging    They had been waterlogging

**Waterlog in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will waterlog                          We will waterlog  
You will waterlog                      You will waterlog  
He/She/It will waterlog              They will waterlog

**Waterlog in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be waterlogging                We will be waterlogging  
You will be waterlogging              You will be waterlogging  
He/She/It will be waterlogging      They will be waterlogging

**Waterlog in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**I will have waterlogged**

**You will have waterlogged**

**He/She/It will have waterlogged**

**Plural**

**We will have waterlogged**

**You will have waterlogged**

**They will have waterlogged**

**I will have been waterlogging**

**You will have been waterlogging**

**He/She/It will have been waterlogging**
