<b>abide</b>	Dwell. <i>If there is one thing I cannot <b>abide</b> it is a lack of discipline.</i>
<b>be</b>	Have an existence be extant. <i>He s a tough customer let him <b>be</b>.</i>
<b>denigrate</b>	Charge falsely or with malicious intent; attack the good name and reputation of someone. <i>Doom and gloom merchants who <b>denigrate</b> their own country.</i>
<b>derogatory</b>	Showing a critical or disrespectful attitude. <i>She tells me I m fat and is always making <b>derogatory</b> remarks.</i>
<b>disparaging</b>	Expressive of low opinion. <i><b>Disparaging</b> remarks about the new house.</i>
<b><u> dwell</u></b>	Think moodily or anxiously about something. <i>Groups of people still <b> dwell</b> in these caves.</i>
<b>dweller</b>	A person who inhabits a particular place. <i>The majority of urban <b> dwellers</b> live in small apartments.</i>
<b><u> eternally</u></b>	Used to emphasize expressions of admiration, gratitude, etc. <i>His <b> eternally</b> optimistic attitude.</i>
<b>existence</b>	Continued survival. <i>A person may be reaping the consequences of evil deeds sown in previous <b> existences</b>.</i>
<b><u> existential</u></b>	Of or as conceived by existentialism. <i>Formal logicians are not concerned with <b> existential</b> matters.</i>
<b>existing</b>	Existing in something specified. <i>Much of the beluga caviar <b> existing</b> in the world is found in the Soviet Union and Iran.</i>
<b>habitant</b>	An inhabitant. <i>The <b> habitant</b> farmhouses of old Quebec.</i>

<b>habitat</b>	A person's usual or preferred surroundings. <i>Wild chimps in their natural <b>habitat</b>.</i>
<b>horizontally</b>	In a horizontal direction. <i>Labels are placed <b>horizontally</b> on the cases.</i>
<b>immortalize</b>	Make famous forever. <i>This melody <b>immortalized</b> its composer.</i>
<b>incarnation</b>	The form taken by a person or thing during an incarnation. <i>In a previous journalistic <b>incarnation</b> I worked at Westminster.</i>
<b>inhabit</b>	Be an inhabitant of or reside in. <i>Strange notions <b>inhabited</b> her mind.</i>
<b>inhabitant</b>	A person or animal that lives in or occupies a place.
<b>lifelong</b>	Lasting or remaining in a particular state throughout a person's life. <i>A <b>lifelong</b> Conservative.</i>
<b>live</b>	Continue to live through hardship or adversity. <i><b>Live</b> coals.</i>
<b>living</b>	People who are still living. <i>The benefits of country <b>living</b>.</i>
<b>oriented</b>	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>The book is value <b>oriented</b> throughout.</i>
<b>outlast</b>	Live or last longer than. <i>The kind of beauty that will <b>outlast</b> youth.</i>
<b>pejorative</b>	Expressing disapproval. <i>Permissiveness is used almost universally as a <b>pejorative</b> term.</i>
<b>populate</b>	Fill with inhabitants. <i>The island is <b>populated</b> by scarcely 40 000 people.</i>
<b>presence</b>	The state of being present; current existence. <i>He felt the <b>presence</b> of an evil force.</i>
<b>reside</b>	Make one's home in a particular place or community. <i>The meaning of an utterance does not wholly <b>reside</b> in the semantic meaning.</i>
<b>stay</b>	A period of staying somewhere in particular of living somewhere temporarily as a visitor or guest. <i>We are <b>staying</b> in Detroit we are not moving to Cincinnati.</i>
<b>survive</b>	Continue to live and avoid dying. <i>He <b>survived</b> the cancer against all odds.</i>
