Associations of "Way of thinking" (30 Words)

analytical	Relating to or using analysis or logical reasoning. <i>A suave analytical type who missed his calling as a lawyer.</i>
<u>architectural</u>	Relating to the art or practice of designing and constructing buildings. <i>He liked architectural plants particularly large spiky palms.</i>
attitude	Individuality and self-confidence. <i>She snapped her fingers with attitude.</i>
cognitive	Relating to cognition. <i>The cognitive processes involved in reading.</i>
<u>conceivable</u>	Capable of being imagined or grasped mentally. <i>A mass uprising was entirely conceivable.</i>
<u>conceive</u>	Judge or regard; look upon; judge. <i>The dam project was originally conceived in 1977.</i>
creative	A person whose job involves creative work. <i>The most important people in the mix will be creatives and direct marketing specialists.</i>
deducible	Capable of being deduced.
deductive	Characterized by or based on the inference of particular instances from a general law. <i>I used my deductive powers.</i>
defeatist	Demonstrating expectation or acceptance of failure. <i>We have a duty not to be so defeatist.</i>
derogatory	Showing a critical or disrespectful attitude. <i>She tells me I m fat and is always making derogatory remarks.</i>
dialectic	Of or relating to or employing dialectic. <i>The dialectical method.</i>

dialectical	Relating to the logical discussion of ideas and opinions. <i>A dialectical opposition between social convention and individual libertarianism.</i>
disparaging	Expressing the opinion that something is of little worth; derogatory. <i>Disparaging remarks about the new house.</i>
imaginable	Possible to be thought of or believed. <i>The most spectacular views imaginable.</i>
logic	Logical operations collectively. <i>It made a certain kind of logic.</i>
manner	The way a motor vehicle handles or performs. <i>Her dignified manner.</i>
means	Financial resources; income. <i>Resolving disputes by peaceful means.</i>
mentality	The capacity for intelligent thought. <i>I had inherited not only my father's blood but his bourgeois mentality as well.</i>
method	A way of doing something, especially a systematic way; implies an orderly logical arrangement (usually in steps). <i>Labour intensive production methods.</i>
methodology	The system of methods followed in a particular discipline. <i>Courses in research methodology and practice.</i>
minded	(used in combination) mentally oriented toward something specified. <i>Conservation minded citizens.</i>
oriented	Adjusted or located in relation to surroundings or circumstances; sometimes used in combination. <i>The book is value oriented throughout.</i>
pejorative	Expressing disapproval. <i>Permissiveness is used almost universally as a pejorative term.</i>
politic	Engage in political activity. <i>He was too politic to quarrel with so important a personage.</i>
sagacious	Having or showing keen mental discernment and good judgement; wise or shrewd. <i>Observant and thoughtful he was given to asking sagacious questions.</i>

syllogism

An instance of a form of reasoning in which a conclusion is drawn from two given or assumed propositions (premises); a common or middle term is present in the two premises but not in the conclusion, which may be invalid (e.g. all dogs are animals; all animals have four legs; therefore all dogs have four legs).

*This school of epistemology is highly advanced in **syllogism** and logical reasoning.*

theory

A well-substantiated explanation of some aspect of the natural world; an organized system of accepted knowledge that applies in a variety of circumstances to explain a specific set of phenomena.

*True in fact and **theory**.*

think

An instance of deliberate thinking.

***Think** good thoughts.*

thought

To a small extent; somewhat.

*I haven't given it much **thought**.*
