theory

An instance of a form of reasoning in which a conclusion is drawn from two given or assumed propositions (premises); a common or middle term is present in the two premises but not in the conclusion, which may be invalid (e.g. all dogs are animals; all animals have four legs; therefore all dogs have

four legs).

This school of epistemology is highly advanced in **syllogism** and logical reasoning.

A well-substantiated explanation of some aspect of the natural world; an organized system of accepted knowledge that applies in a variety of

circumstances to explain a specific set of phenomena.

True in fact and **theory**.

think An instance of deliberate thinking.
