# **Conjugate Way**

#### Way in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense



Singular	Plural
I <b>way</b>	We way
You <b>way</b>	You <b>way</b>
He/She/It ways	They <b>way</b>

#### Way in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I <b>am waying</b>	We <b>are waying</b>
You <b>are waying</b>	You <b>are waying</b>
He/She/It is waying	They <b>are waying</b>

#### Way in Present Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I have wayed	We have wayed
You <b>have wayed</b>	You have wayed
He/She/It has wayed	They have wayed

#### Way in Present Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I have been waying	We have been waying
You <b>have been waying</b>	You have been waying
He/She/It has been waying	They have been waying

#### Way in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I wayed	We <b>wayed</b>
You <b>wayed</b>	You <b>wayed</b>
He/She/It wayed	They wayed

#### Way in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense



Singular	Plural
I was waying	We <b>were waying</b>
You <b>were waying</b>	You <b>were waying</b>
He/She/It was waying	They were waying

#### Way in Past Perfect Tense

Singular	Plural
I had wayed	We had wayed
You <b>had wayed</b>	You <b>had wayed</b>
He/She/It had wayed	They had wayed

#### Way in Past Perfect Continuous Tense

Singular	Plural
I had been waying	We had been waying
You <b>had been waying</b>	You had been waying
He/She/It had been waying	They had been waying

## Way in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will way	We <b>will way</b>
You <b>will way</b>	You <b>will way</b>
He/She/It will way	They will way

### Way in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense

Singular	Plural
I will be waying	We <b>will be waying</b>
You <b>will be waying</b>	You <b>will be waying</b>
He/She/It will be waying	They will be waying

#### Way in Future Perfect Tense



SingularPluralI will have wayedWe will have wayedYou will have wayedYou will have wayedHe/She/It will have wayedThey will have wayed

#### Way in Future Perfect Continuous Tense

SingularPluralI will have been wayingWe will have been wayingYou will have been wayingYou will have been wayingHe/She/It will have been wayingThey will have been waying
