Weasel as a Noun

Definitions of "Weasel" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “weasel” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *A stoat.*
- *A small, slender carnivorous mammal related to, but smaller than, the stoat.*
- *A person who is regarded as treacherous or sneaky.*
- *A deceitful or treacherous person.*
- *Small carnivorous mammal with short legs and elongated body and neck.*



Synonyms of "Weasel" as a noun (3 Words)

- rogue** A deceitful and unreliable scoundrel.
*Cenzo you old **rogue**.*
- scoundrel** A dishonest or unscrupulous person; a rogue.
*That **scoundrel** sets a bad example for the other young men.*
- wretch** Someone you feel sorry for.
*Can the poor **wretch** s corpse tell us anything.*



Usage Examples of "Weasel" as a noun

- *He was a double-crossing weasel.*
