Associations of "Well thought out" (30 Words)

abstraction	The process of considering something independently of its associations or attributes. <i>The question can no longer be treated as an academic abstraction.</i>
brainstorming	A group problem-solving technique in which members spontaneously share ideas and solutions. <i>A brainstorming session.</i>
chimerical	Being or relating to or like a chimera- Douglas Bush. <i>His Utopia is not a chimerical commonwealth but a practical improvement on what already exists.</i>
conceivable	Capable of being imagined. <i>The body was photographed from every conceivable angle.</i>
conceive	Become pregnant; undergo conception. <i>The racist conceives such people to be inferior.</i>
concept	An abstract or general idea inferred or derived from specific instances. <i>The concept of justice.</i>
conception	The action of conceiving a child or of one being conceived. <i>A rise in premarital conceptions.</i>
creative	A person whose job involves creative work. <i>A creative imagination.</i>
defeatist	Someone who is resigned to defeat without offering positive suggestions. <i>We have a duty not to be so defeatist.</i>
groundbreaking	Innovative; pioneering. <i>Groundbreaking research into fertility problems.</i>
idea	(music) melodic subject of a musical composition. <i>It s a good idea to do some research before you go.</i>
imagery	The ability to form mental images of things or events. <i>The impact of computer generated imagery on contemporary art.</i>

imaginable	Possible to be thought of or believed. <i>The most spectacular views imaginable.</i>
<u>imaginative</u>	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>He was imaginative beyond all other architects.</i>
innovative	(of a person) introducing new ideas; original and creative in thinking. <i>Innovative ways to help unemployed people.</i>
inspired	(of a person) displaying a creative impulse in the activity specified. <i>They had to thank the goalkeeper for some inspired saves.</i>
<u>invention</u>	Something, typically a process or device, that has been invented. <i>You know my story is an invention.</i>
<u>inventive</u>	Having the ability to create or design new things or to think originally. <i>A courageous and inventive piece of film making.</i>
mean	Mean or intend to express or convey. <i>A mean hut.</i>
mediocrity	A person of mediocre ability. <i>The team suddenly came good after years of mediocrity.</i>
<u>mentality</u>	The capacity for intelligent thought. <i>Machines can possess mentality.</i>
minded	Inclined to think in a particular way. <i>Liberal minded scholars.</i>
philosophical	Having or showing a calm attitude towards disappointments or difficulties. <i>He was philosophical about losing the contract.</i>
<u>reasoning</u>	Endowed with the capacity to reason. <i>He explained the reasoning behind his decision at a media conference.</i>
<u>resourceful</u>	Having inner resources; adroit or imaginative. <i>The most resourceful cook in town.</i>
seminal	Strongly influencing later developments. <i>His seminal work on chaos theory.</i>
superbly	Extremely well. <i>The team played superbly.</i>
think	An instance of deliberate thinking. <i>I think that he is her boyfriend.</i>
thinking	Using thought or rational judgement; intelligent. <i>I am wrapped in dismal thinkings.</i>

(used as an intensifier) extremely well.
