anodyne	Not likely to cause offence or disagreement and somewhat dull. <i>The anodyne properties of certain drugs.</i>

carefree	Free from anxiety or responsibility. <i>We were young and carefree.</i>

conciseness	Terseness and economy in writing and speaking achieved by expressing a great deal in just a few words.
considerably	To a great extent or degree. <i>A considerably higher density.</i>
convenient	Large and roomy convenient is archaic in this sense. <i>The site would have to be convenient for London.</i>
conveniently	In a way that fits well with particular needs, activities, and plans. <i>The switch was conveniently located.</i>
directness	The quality of proceeding in a straight line without deflection. <i>I like the simplicity and directness of the image.</i>

<u>ease</u>	Of share prices interest rates etc decrease in value or amount. <i>I eased down the slope with care.</i>
easily	With ease easy is sometimes used informally for easily. <i>This china breaks very easily.</i>
easiness	A feeling of refreshing tranquility and an absence of tension or worry. <i>The easiness we feel when sleeping.</i>
<u>facile</u>	Ignoring the true complexities of an issue; superficial. <i>Too facile a solution for so complex a problem.</i>
familiarly	In an intimately familiar manner.
generality	The quality of being general or widespread or having general applicability. <i>His service was better than that offered by the generality of doctors.</i>
<u>handy</u>	Easy to use. <i>Found a handy spot for the can opener.</i>
<u>leisurely</u>	In an unhurried way or at one's convenience. <i>A leisurely breakfast at our hotel.</i>
lope	A long bounding stride. <i>They set off at a fast lope.</i>
<u>pushover</u>	A try in which one side in a scrum pushes the ball over the opponents' goal line. <i>Colonel Moore was benevolent but no pushover.</i>
safely	Without being injured or harmed. <i>We are relieved to have arrived safely.</i>
simple	Humble and unpretentious. <i>The simple truth.</i>
simplicity	The quality or condition of being easy to understand or do. <i>For the sake of simplicity this chapter will concentrate upon one theory.</i>
simplification	The process of making something simpler or easier to do or understand. <i>He is proposing simplification of the planning system.</i>
<u>straightforward</u>	Without evasion or compromise. <i>A straightforward set of instructions.</i>
<u>supple</u>	(used of persons' bodies) capable of moving or bending freely. <i>This body oil leaves your skin feeling deliciously supple.</i>
<u>understatement</u>	The presentation of something as being smaller or less good or important than it really is. <i>A master of English understatement.</i>
