## The Forms of Wet

Infinitive	<b>to wet</b>
Present Tense	<b>wet / wets</b>
Past Tense	<b>wet or wetted</b>
Present Participle	<b>wetting</b>
Past Participle	<b>wet or wetted</b>

## Conjugate Wet

**Wet in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>wet</b>	We <b>wet</b>
You <b>wet</b>	You <b>wet</b>
He/She/It <b>wets</b>	They <b>wet</b>

## **Wet in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>am wetting</b>	We <b>are wetting</b>
You <b>are wetting</b>	You <b>are wetting</b>
He/She/It <b>is wetting</b>	They <b>are wetting</b>

## **Wet in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have wet or wetted</b>	We <b>have wet or wetted</b>
You <b>have wet or wetted</b>	You <b>have wet or wetted</b>
He/She/It <b>has wet or wetted</b>	They <b>have wet or wetted</b>

## **Wet in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>have been wetting</b>	We <b>have been wetting</b>
You <b>have been wetting</b>	You <b>have been wetting</b>
He/She/It <b>has been wetting</b>	They <b>have been wetting</b>

## **Wet in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
-----------------	---------------

I <b>wet or wetted</b>	We <b>wet or wetted</b>
You <b>wet or wetted</b>	You <b>wet or wetted</b>
He/She/It <b>wet or wetted</b>	They <b>wet or wetted</b>

## **Wet in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I was wetting</b>	<b>We were wetting</b>
<b>You were wetting</b>	<b>You were wetting</b>
<b>He/She/It was wetting</b>	<b>They were wetting</b>

**Wet in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had wet or wetted</b>	<b>We had wet or wetted</b>
<b>You had wet or wetted</b>	<b>You had wet or wetted</b>
<b>He/She/It had wet or wetted</b>	<b>They had wet or wetted</b>

**Wet in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I had been wetting</b>	<b>We had been wetting</b>
<b>You had been wetting</b>	<b>You had been wetting</b>
<b>He/She/It had been wetting</b>	<b>They had been wetting</b>

**Wet in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will wet</b>	<b>We will wet</b>
<b>You will wet</b>	<b>You will wet</b>
<b>He/She/It will wet</b>	<b>They will wet</b>

**Wet in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

<b>I will be wetting</b>	<b>We will be wetting</b>
<b>You will be wetting</b>	<b>You will be wetting</b>
<b>He/She/It will be wetting</b>	<b>They will be wetting</b>

**Wet in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have wet or wetted**

**We will have wet or wetted**

**You will have wet or wetted**

**You will have wet or wetted**

**He/She/It will have wet or wetted**

**They will have wet or wetted**

**Wet in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been wetting**

**We will have been wetting**

**You will have been wetting**

**You will have been wetting**

**He/She/It will have been wetting**

**They will have been wetting**
