#### Definitions of "Wharf" as a noun

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "wharf" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- A level quayside area to which a ship may be moored to load and unload.
- A platform built out from the shore into the water and supported by piles; provides access to ships and boats.





## Synonyms of "Wharf" as a noun (9 Words)

**berth** A bed on a ship or train; usually in tiers.

The vessel had left its **berth**.

A device in which a laptop smartphone or other mobile device may be

placed for charging providing access to a power supply and to peripheral

devices or auxiliary features a docking station.

The boat nosed up to a **dock**.

**jetty**A bridge or staircase used by passengers boarding an aircraft.

Pan jumped schore and tied the roughest up to the small wood.

Ben jumped ashore and tied the rowboat up to the small wooden **jetty**.

The act of coming to land after a voyage.

The ferry landing.

dock

**landing place** Structure providing a place where boats can land people or goods.

**landing stage** Structure providing a place where boats can land people or goods.

**pier** A solid support designed to sustain vertical pressure.



quay

Wharf usually built parallel to the shoreline.

wharfage

Accommodation provided at a wharf for the loading, unloading, or storage

of goods.




### Wharf as a Verb

#### Definitions of "Wharf" as a verb

According to the <u>Oxford Dictionary of English</u>, "wharf" as a verb can have the following definitions:

- Store on a wharf.
- Moor at a wharf.
- Come into or dock at a wharf.
- Discharge at a wharf.
- Provide with a wharf.





# Synonyms of "Wharf" as a verb (2 Words)

**berth** Secure in or as if in a berth or dock. *The ship* **berth**ed at Plymouth.

 $\begin{array}{l} \textbf{moor} \ \ \textbf{Secure in or as if in a berth or dock.} \\ \textbf{\textit{Moor the boat.}} \end{array}$

- ullet The big ship wharfed in the evening.
- Wharf the passengers.
- The ship was wharfed.
