Definitions of "Wherewithal" as a noun

According to the [Oxford Dictionary of English](#), “wherewithal” as a noun can have the following definitions:

- *The money or other means needed for a particular purpose.*
- *The necessary means (especially financial means).*

Synonyms of "Wherewithal" as a noun (9 Words)

capital	A center that is associated more than any other with some activity or product. <i>There is insufficient investment in human capital.</i>
cash	Money in the form of bills or coins. <i>A discount for cash.</i>
finance	The management of large amounts of money, especially by governments or large companies. <i>The club's finances are stretched to the limit.</i>
finances	The commercial activity of providing funds and capital.
funds	Assets in the form of money.
money	Wealth reckoned in terms of money. <i>All his money is in real estate.</i>

ready money Poised for action.

reserves Civilians trained as soldiers but not part of the regular army.

resources Available source of wealth; a new or reserve supply that can be drawn upon when needed.
A man of resource.
