Definitions of "Whiny" as an adjective

fretful Feeling or expressing distress or irritation.

A constant **fretful** stamping of hooves.

querulous Habitually complaining.

She became **querulous** and demanding.

whiney Habitually complaining.

- A nasal, whiny singer.
- A whiny child.
- $\bullet \ \textit{My PC suddenly emits this horrible whiny noise}.$
- Without wanting to sound whiny, it's quite hard work.
- He speaks in a whiny, childish voice.
