Definitions of "Whiplash" as a noun

According to the Oxford Dictionary of English, "whiplash" as a noun can have the following definitions:

- Injury caused by a severe jerk to the head, typically in a car accident.
- A quick blow delivered with a whip or whiplike object.
- An injury to the neck (the cervical vertebrae) resulting from rapid acceleration or deceleration (as in an automobile accident.
- The flexible part of a whip or something resembling it.
- Used with reference to something resembling a blow with a whip.

Synonyms of "Whiplash" as a noun (3 Words)

lash An eyelash.

They were living under the threat of the **lash**.

whip A written notice from a whip requesting attendance for voting.

I just got new wheels for my **whip**.

whiplash injury A casualty to military personnel resulting from combat.

- Suffering from whiplash, he spent weeks with his neck in a collar.
