## Associations of "Wholeheartedly" (30 Words)

<a href="#"><b>adherence</b></a>	The property of sticking together (as of glue and wood) or the joining of surfaces of different composition. <i><b>Adherence</b> to a fat free diet.</i>
<a href="#"><b>allegiance</b></a>	Loyalty or commitment to a superior or to a group or cause. <i>A complex pattern of cross party <b>allegiances</b>.</i>
<b>authenticity</b>	Undisputed credibility. <i>The paper should have established the <b>authenticity</b> of the documents before publishing them.</i>
<a href="#"><b>candid</b></a>	Characterized by directness in manner or speech; without subtlety or evasion. <i>It is better to let the photographer mingle among the guests and take <b>candid</b> shots.</i>
<a href="#"><b>candor</b></a>	Ability to make judgments free from discrimination or dishonesty.
<a href="#"><b>commitment</b></a>	A pledge or undertaking. <i>His long <b>commitment</b> to public service.</i>
<a href="#"><b>covenant</b></a>	An agreement which brings about a relationship of commitment between God and his people The Jewish faith is based on the biblical covenants made with Abraham Moses and David. <i>The landlord <b>covenants</b> to repair the property.</i>
<a href="#"><b>dedication</b></a>	An inscription or form of words dedicating a building, book, etc. to a person or deity. <i>The <b>dedication</b> of a new city church.</i>
<a href="#"><b>devotion</b></a>	Religious worship or observance. <i>He returned to his <b>devotions</b>.</i>
<b>encyclical</b>	A letter from the pope sent to all Roman Catholic bishops throughout the world. <i>An <b>encyclical</b> letter.</i>

<b>faithfully</b>	In a loyal manner. <i>She translated the novel as <b>faithfully</b> as possible.</i>
<b>faithfulness</b>	The quality of being faithful; fidelity. <i><b>Faithfulness</b> in marriage.</i>
<b>fealty</b>	The loyalty that citizens owe to their country (or subjects to their sovereign). <i>A property for which she did <b>fealty</b>.</i>
<b>fidelity</b>	Accuracy with which an electronic system reproduces the sound or image of its input signal. <i>His <b>fidelity</b> to liberal ideals.</i>
<b>frank</b>	Characterized by directness in manner or speech; without subtlety or evasion. <i>To be perfectly <b>frank</b> I don't know.</i>
<u>frankly</u>	In an open, honest, and direct manner. <i><b>Frankly</b> I was pleased to leave.</i>
<u>honesty</u>	A European plant with purple or white flowers and round, flat, translucent seed pods which are used for indoor flower arrangements. <i>They spoke with convincing <b>honesty</b> about their fears.</i>
<b>loyalty</b>	The act of binding yourself (intellectually or emotionally) to a course of action. <i>They felt no <b>loyalty</b> to a losing team.</i>
<b>piety</b>	A belief which is accepted with unthinking conventional reverence. <i>Acts of <b>piety</b> and charity.</i>
<u>pledge</u>	Bind or secure by a pledge. <i>I <b>pledged</b> 10 a month to my favorite radio station.</i>
<b>posterity</b>	The descendants of a person. <i>We must secure the benefits of freedom for ourselves and our <b>posterity</b>.</i>
<b>righteousness</b>	Adhering to moral principles. <i>We had little doubt about the <b>righteousness</b> of our cause.</i>
<u>sanctity</u>	The quality of being holy. <i>The site of the tomb was a place of <b>sanctity</b> for the ancient Egyptians.</i>
<u>seriousness</u>	The quality of arousing fear or distress. <i>He learned the <b>seriousness</b> of his illness.</i>
<u>sincere</u>	Open and genuine; not deceitful. <i>An entirely <b>sincere</b> and cruel tyrant.</i>
<u>sincerity</u>	The absence of pretence, deceit, or hypocrisy. <i>His <b>sincerity</b> inspired belief.</i>

<b>troth</b>	Truth. <i>A token of <b>troth</b>.</i>
<u><b>truthfulness</b></u>	The quality of being truthful. <i>We have had to judge the <b>truthfulness</b> of the evidence.</i>
<u><b>undying</b></u>	(especially of an emotion) lasting forever. <i>His <b>undying</b> fame.</i>
<u><b>veracity</b></u>	Conformity to facts; accuracy. <i>Voters should be concerned about his <b>veracity</b> and character.</i>
