| shock of hair | Bodily collapse or near collapse caused by inadequate oxygen delivery to the cells; characterized by reduced cardiac output and rapid heartbeat and circulatory insufficiency and pallor. |
| wigging | A severe rebuke. The presenter gave the PM a wigging . |
