## The Forms of Will

Infinitive	<b>to will</b>
Present Tense	<b>will / wills</b>
Past Tense	<b>willed or rarely would</b>
Present Participle	<b>willing</b>
Past Participle	<b>willed</b>

## Conjugate Will

**Will in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>will</b>	We <b>will</b>
You <b>will</b>	You <b>will</b>
He/She/It <b>wills</b>	They <b>will</b>

### **Will in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>am willing</b>	We <b>are willing</b>
You <b>are willing</b>	You <b>are willing</b>
He/She/It <b>is willing</b>	They <b>are willing</b>

### **Will in Present Perfect Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have willed</b>	We <b>have willed</b>
You <b>have willed</b>	You <b>have willed</b>
He/She/It <b>has willed</b>	They <b>have willed</b>

### **Will in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>have been willing</b>	We <b>have been willing</b>
You <b>have been willing</b>	You <b>have been willing</b>
He/She/It <b>has been willing</b>	They <b>have been willing</b>

### **Will in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

<b>Singular</b>	<b>Plural</b>
I <b>willed or rarely would</b>	We <b>willed or rarely would</b>
You <b>willed or rarely would</b>	You <b>willed or rarely would</b>
He/She/It <b>willed or rarely would</b>	They <b>willed or rarely would</b>

### **Will in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **was willing**                      We **were willing**  
You **were willing**                You **were willing**  
He/She/It **was willing**        They **were willing**

**Will in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had willed**                      We **had willed**  
You **had willed**                You **had willed**  
He/She/It **had willed**        They **had willed**

**Will in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **had been willing**                We **had been willing**  
You **had been willing**            You **had been willing**  
He/She/It **had been willing**    They **had been willing**

**Will in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will will**                      We **will will**  
You **will will**                You **will will**  
He/She/It **will will**        They **will will**

**Will in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I **will be willing**                We **will be willing**  
You **will be willing**            You **will be willing**  
He/She/It **will be willing**    They **will be willing**

**Will in Future Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have willed**

**We will have willed**

**You will have willed**

**You will have willed**

**He/She/It will have willed**

**They will have willed**

**Will in Future Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

**I will have been willing**

**We will have been willing**

**You will have been willing**

**You will have been willing**

**He/She/It will have been willing**

**They will have been willing**
