self-command	The trait of resolutely controlling your own behavior.
self-control	The act of denying yourself controlling your impulses.
self-possession	The trait of resolutely controlling your own behavior.
self-will	Resolute adherence to your own ideas or desires.
will power	The capability of conscious choice and decision and intention- George Meredith.
