Infinitive	<b>to window-shop</b>
Present Tense	<b>window-shop / window-shops</b>
Past Tense	<b>window-shopped</b>
Present Participle	<b>window-shopping</b>
Past Participle	<b>window-shopped</b>

## Conjugate Window-shop

**Window-shop in Present Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>window-shop</b>	We <b>window-shop</b>
You <b>window-shop</b>	You <b>window-shop</b>
He/She/It <b>window-shops</b>	They <b>window-shop</b>

### **Window-shop in Present Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>am window-shopping</b>	We <b>are window-shopping</b>
You <b>are window-shopping</b>	You <b>are window-shopping</b>
He/She/It <b>is window-shopping</b>	They <b>are window-shopping</b>

### **Window-shop in Present Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have window-shopped</b>	We <b>have window-shopped</b>
You <b>have window-shopped</b>	You <b>have window-shopped</b>
He/She/It <b>has window-shopped</b>	They <b>have window-shopped</b>

### **Window-shop in Present Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>have been window-shopping</b>	We <b>have been window-shopping</b>
You <b>have been window-shopping</b>	You <b>have been window-shopping</b>
He/She/It <b>has been window-shopping</b>	They <b>have been window-shopping</b>

### **Window-shop in Past Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I <b>window-shopped</b>	We <b>window-shopped</b>
You <b>window-shopped</b>	You <b>window-shopped</b>
He/She/It <b>window-shopped</b>	They <b>window-shopped</b>

### **Window-shop in Past Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I was window-shopping      We were window-shopping  
You were window-shopping      You were window-shopping  
He/She/It was window-shopping      They were window-shopping

**Window-shop in Past Perfect Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had window-shopped      We had window-shopped  
You had window-shopped      You had window-shopped  
He/She/It had window-shopped      They had window-shopped

**Window-shop in Past Perfect Continuous Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I had been window-shopping      We had been window-shopping  
You had been window-shopping      You had been window-shopping  
He/She/It had been window-shopping      They had been window-shopping

**Window-shop in Future Simple (Indefinite) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will window-shop      We will window-shop  
You will window-shop      You will window-shop  
He/She/It will window-shop      They will window-shop

**Window-shop in Future Continuous (Progressive) Tense**

**Singular**

**Plural**

I will be window-shopping      We will be window-shopping  
You will be window-shopping      You will be window-shopping  
He/She/It will be window-shopping      They will be window-shopping

**I will have window-shopped**

**We will have window-shopped**

**You will have window-shopped**

**You will have window-shopped**

**He/She/It will have window-shopped** **They will have window-shopped**

**I will have been window-shopping**

**We will have been window-shopping**

**You will have been window-shopping**
