Associations of "With this in mind" (30 Words)

absorbed	Giving or marked by complete attention to. <i>The absorbed light intensity.</i>
anxious	Feeling or showing worry, nervousness, or unease about something with an uncertain outcome. <i>Anxious to see the new show at the museum.</i>
concentration	Strengthening the concentration as of a solute in a mixture by removing diluting material. <i>The gas can collect in dangerous concentrations.</i>
concerned	Involved in or affected by or having a claim to or share in. <i>Greatly concerned not to disappoint a small child.</i>
consciousness	An alert cognitive state in which you are aware of yourself and your situation. <i>He lost consciousness.</i>
dejection	A sad and depressed state; low spirits. <i>He was slumped in deep dejection.</i>
disembodied	Not having a material body. <i>A disembodied ghost.</i>
disposed	Naturally disposed toward. <i>He is favourably disposed towards the proposals.</i>
excitable	Easily excited. <i>These alkaloids act on nerve cells to make them more excitable.</i>
focused	Directing a great deal of attention, interest, or activity towards a particular aim. <i>The need for more focused research.</i>

hypnosis	The induction of a state of consciousness in which a person apparently loses the power of voluntary action and is highly responsive to suggestion or direction. Its use in therapy, typically to recover suppressed memories or to allow modification of behaviour, has been revived but is still controversial. <i>I was regressed under hypnosis.</i>
inclined	Having a preference, disposition, or tendency. <i>Inclined to be moody.</i>
incorporeal	Having no physical existence. <i>An incorporeal spirit.</i>
inland	Carried on within the limits of a country; domestic. <i>The inland port of Gloucester.</i>
intentionally	Deliberately; on purpose. <i>I wasn't sure if it was intentionally funny or not.</i>
internal	Inner parts or features. <i>The nation's internal politics.</i>
mental	Done by or occurring in the mind. <i>Mental images of happy times.</i>
parapsychology	Phenomena that appear to contradict physical laws and suggest the possibility of causation by mental processes.
position	An opinion that is held in opposition to another in an argument or dispute. <i>The company's financial position is grim.</i>
preoccupation	The state or condition of being preoccupied or engrossed with something. <i>Their main preoccupation was how to feed their families.</i>
psyche	That which is responsible for one's thoughts, feelings, and conscious brain functions; the seat of the faculty of reason. <i>How does constant losing affect the psyches of young athletes.</i>
restlessly	In a restless manner.
semiconscious	Partially conscious; not completely aware of sensations.
sense	Become aware of not through the senses but instinctively. <i>He hasn't got the sense God gave little green apples.</i>
sensitize	Make (an organism) abnormally sensitive to a foreign substance. <i>Long term exposure to this medicine may sensitize you to the allergen.</i>
spirit	Infuse with spirit. <i>The rule had been broken in spirit if not in letter.</i>

<u>subconscious</u>	The subconscious part of the mind not in technical use in psychoanalysis where unconscious is preferred. <i>Uncertainties were lurking around the edge of her subconscious.</i>
think	An instance of deliberate thinking. <i>Any writer who so rarely produces a book is not thinking deep thoughts.</i>
thoughtful	Taking heed giving close and thoughtful attention. <i>Brows drawn together in thoughtful consideration.</i>
<u>uneasy</u>	Lacking a sense of security or affording no ease or reassurance. <i>An uneasy coalition government.</i>
