deplorably In an unfortunate or deplorable manner.

lamentably In an unfortunate or deplorable manner. She was **lamentably** ignorant.

She was tamentably tynorant.

sadlyTo a regrettable extent; regrettably.
He smiled sadly.

Usage Examples of "Woefully" as an adverb

- It was woefully inadequate.
- She sighed woefully and walked out.
- They performed woefully to lose 2-0.
- David talks woefully of life.
- Preparations proved woefully inadequate.
