*He played **marvellously**.*
- marvelously** Extremely well.
- superbly** In an impressively splendid manner.
*The team played **superbly**.*
- terrifically** With great intensity; to a great extent.
*She is doing **terrifically** in the show.*
- toppingly** (used as an intensifier) extremely well.
- wondrously** Marvellously; wonderfully.
*The colors changed **wondrously** slowly.*

colorful	Having striking color. <i>A colorful character.</i>
creativity	The ability to create. <i>Firms are keen to encourage creativity.</i>
ebullient	(of liquid or matter) boiling or agitated as if boiling. <i>Misted and ebullient seas.</i>
eidetic	Of visual imagery of almost photographic accuracy. <i>An eidetic memory.</i>
exuberant	Produced or growing in extreme abundance. <i>A noisy bunch of exuberant youngsters.</i>
fancy	Have a fancy or particular liking or desire for. <i>All pelargoniums from scented leaf species to fancy hybrids thrive in hot sunshine.</i>
fine	Issue a ticket or a fine to as a penalty. <i>Another minute I d have been fine.</i>
glorious	Having great beauty and splendor. <i>A glorious work of art.</i>
good	Completely and absolutely good is sometimes used informally for thoroughly. <i>He convinces his father to use his genius for the good of mankind.</i>
idealize	Form ideals. <i>She idealized her husband after his death.</i>
ideally	In an ideal manner. <i>Ideally you should exercise for 30 minutes every day.</i>
imaginative	Marked by independence and creativity in thought or action- Lewis Mumford. <i>An imaginative use of material.</i>
lively	(of a place or atmosphere) full of activity and excitement. <i>A lively discussion.</i>
luxuriant	Displaying luxury and furnishing gratification to the senses. <i>She tossed her luxuriant dark hair.</i>
magnificent	Characterized by grandeur. <i>Magnificent cathedrals.</i>

overweening	Unrestrained, especially with regard to feelings. <i>No idea how overweening he would be.</i>
praise	Express approval of. <i>He always appreciated praise for his work.</i>
spirited	Made lively or spirited. <i>A spirited dance.</i>
sprightly	Full of spirit and vitality. <i>A sprightly dance.</i>
superbly	Very well; excellently. <i>The tomb is superbly ornamented with fine tracery.</i>
terrific	Causing terror. <i>You look terrific.</i>
vibrant	Of sounds that are strong and resonating. <i>A huge room decorated in vibrant blues and greens.</i>
vivacious	Attractively lively and animated (typically used of a woman). <i>A vivacious folk dance.</i>
well	In a good or proper or satisfactory manner or to a high standard good is a nonstandard dialectal variant for well. <i>We knew them well.</i>
wonderful	Extraordinarily good or great ; used especially as intensifiers. <i>The climate was wonderful all the year round.</i>
